Our on-line catalogue allows you to conveniently search for laws by title, Chapter/Regulation number, or by the ministry responsible. It also allows you to purchase fully formatted copies (in Word or Word-



How to Search the Catalogue

From the home page (see below left), enter the name of the law (complete or partial name) in the field provided under "Catalogue Search" and select the Search button, Or, select the "List Acts" or "List Regulations" buttons. For additional search functions, select the "More options" link.

How to View Laws or Add Documents to Shopping Cart for Purchase

Once the results of your search are returned (see below centre) and you have located the law you require, choose it by selecting its name.

Once the title and associated information is on the screen (see right), select

- "View text of this document" link under the name to access it in TEXT only format. If there is no link, the product is available for purchase
- "Ship Product" link in the "Add to Cart" box to place the law in your shopping cart for purchase.

New Traffic Safety Laws in Alberta

Traffic Safety Act and Regulations in force May 20, 2003

Traffic Safety Act

The Traffic Safety Act, which comes into force May 20, 2003, is a consoli-

dated approach to road safety providing clarity for all road users such as driver instructors, law enforcement and the public. The new legislation replaces six Acts and 64 Regulations (including Highway Traffic Act, Motor Vehicle Administration Act, Motor Transport Act and Off-Highway Vehicle Act) with one Act and 17 Regulations.

Each copy is \$10 plus GST.


Listing of Significant Historical Sites and Areas (2003)

The 4th edition of the Listing of Significant Historical Sites and Areas identifies lands upon which Alberta's most significant historical resources are located.

The listing is the key reference document in regulating "small scale" oil and natural gas industry projects and geophysical survey programs. For example, applicants for a "Well License" must check the 4th edition of the listing. Should a well be located on lands that are identified within the 4th edition, the well requires Historical Resources Act clearance.

Starting on June 1, 2003, the Listing of Significant Historical Sites and Areas (2003) is to be implemented for regulatory approval processes.


