The new edition of the FOIP manual also references Information and Privacy Commissioner Orders and Investigation Reports released up to March 1, 2002.



# **Portraits of Alberta Life**

A Northern Alberta Railway (NAR) train at the settlement of Waterways in the 1930's. Image No. A3936

Formed in 1929, NAR was an amalgamation of the Edmonton, Dunvegan and British Columbia Railway, the Canada Central Railway, the Pembina Valley Railway and the Alberta and Great Waterways Railway (A&GW). These were jointly operated by the CPR and the CNR until 1980. The A&GW was built in 1914 from near Edmonton to Lac La Biche. In 1920, it's owners encountered financial diff-

culties and the Alberta government took control of the line. It was ex-

tended to the settlement of Waterways in 1925. The community was merged with Fort McMurray in 1947. Photo: Provincial Archives of Alberta, Portraits of Alberta
