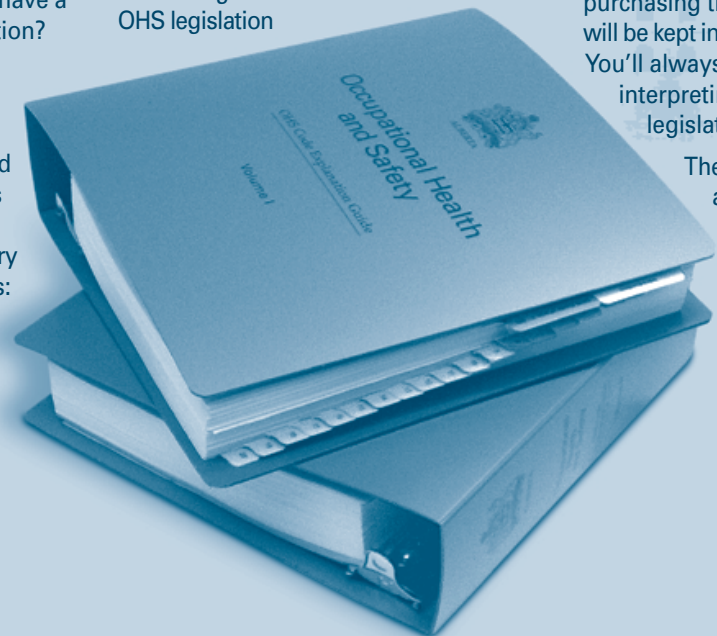

The RSA 2000 Hardbound Statutes of Alberta is a series of bound volumes and its annual bound updates that are considered the official Statutes. In this set, Statutes and amendments to Statutes are presented in their original form. Currently updated to include the 2004 Annual Volume, the complete set is \$800 plus GST.

Alternatively, the RSA 2000 Looseleaf Statutes of Alberta presents Statutes as a series of unbound pages which can be replaced as needed when Statutes are amended.

Statutes can then be viewed in their easy-to-read consolidated form. The complete Looseleaf set, which includes Release 7, is available for \$1895.

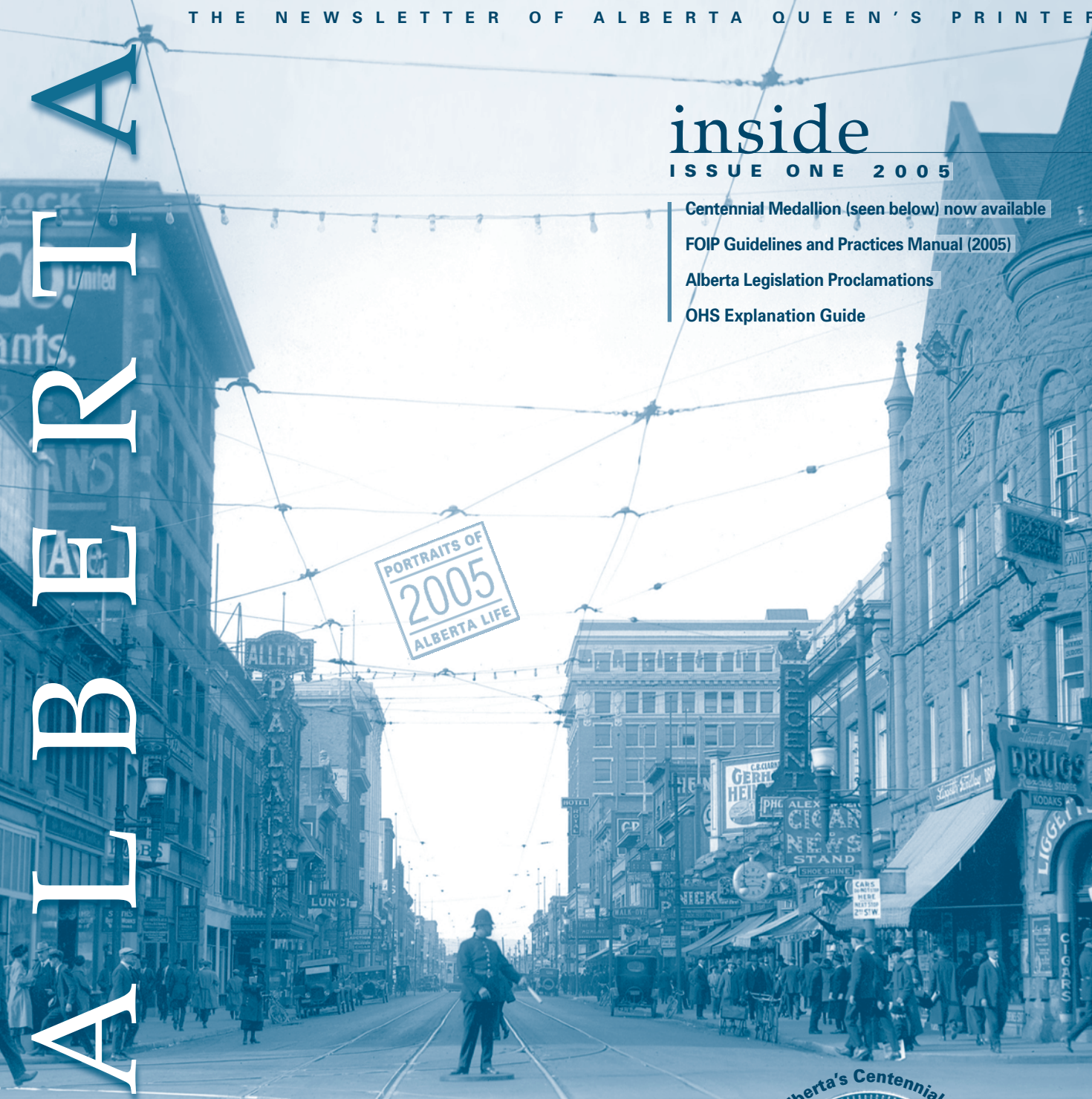

Calgary, 1912. Alberta's cities saw tremendous growth in the first decade of the 20th century, as evidenced by this view of Eighth Avenue and First Street. Many of the buildings lining these streets owe their look of permanence and elegance to the extensive use of sandstone in construction. This locally quarried stone was used for rebuilding after a fire in 1886 destroyed much of the business district.
