## **2005** General Election Financing Reports

**Victoria** – The 2005 General Election financing reports of candidates, registered political parties, registered constituency associations, and election advertising sponsors who have filed reports are now available for public inspection at the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer and on the Elections BC website. Disclosure reports filed by referendum advertising sponsors are also available.

Candidates, registered political parties, registered constituency associations, and election advertising sponsors must file financing reports with the Chief Electoral Officer within 90 days after a provincial election. The deadline for the 2005 General Election financing reports was 4:30 p.m. on August 15, 2005. The reports include the total election expenses of each filer, and information regarding the political contributions they received.

Elections BC will review all of these reports over the next several months.

Under section 280 of the *Election Act*, the Chief Electoral Officer may, in some circumstances, extend deadlines for filing. As a result of requests for filing extensions received prior to the August 15<sup>th</sup> deadline, Orders were made granting 19 extensions.
