APPOINTMENT OF OFFICIAL AGENT - FORM 327 INSTRUCTIONS

PRINT IN BLOCK LETTERS OR TYPE, EXCEPT WHERE A SIGNATURE IS REQUIRED.

PART A

- ① Name of nominee/candidate.
- ② Name of the electoral district in which the nominee/candidate wishes to seek election.
- ③ Name, residential address, phone number, fax number and email address of official agent. Email addresses are also useful.
- ④ A service address is an address at which documents required or authorized under the *Election Act* to be served or delivered to a candidate may be delivered. Documents delivered to this address are deemed to have been delivered or personally served on the candidate [*Election Act*, sections 68 and 69]. This address will be published.
- ⑤ The effective date of appointment means the day on which the official agent assumes that position.
- ⑥ The protection of personal information only applies to residential telephone numbers and residential address.

PART B

- ⑦ The official agent must sign this appointment form indicating their consent and acknowledging the duties and responsibilities of the position. The official agent may act on the candidate's behalf throughout the election process. The official agent can appoint scrutineers and accept notices on the candidate's behalf.

The following persons are disqualified from acting as an official agent:

- individuals who do not have full capacity to enter into contracts;
- individuals who have been convicted of an offence under the *Election Act* or the *Recall and Initiative Act* within the last seven years [*Election Act*, section 179].

PART C

- ⑧ The appointment must be signed by the nominee/candidate.

Signing a false statement is an offence and is subject to the following penalties: a fine of up to \$10 000; imprisonment for two years; or both [*Election Act*, section 266].
