CHAPTER T-3.01

TIME UNIFORMITY ACT

- 1. Subject to section 2, there shall be one uniform, official time in use throughout the province which shall be Atlantic Standard Time. 1995,c.41,s.1
- 2. In each year, Daylight Saving Time, being one hour in advance of Observance of Atlantic Standard Time, shall be observed throughout the province between 2:00 a.m. on the 2nd Sunday in March and 2:00 a.m. on the first Sunday in November. 1995, c.41, s.2; 2006, c.41, s.1.
