Dear Mr. Speaker:

I have the honour to submit the Report of the Chief Electoral Officer pursuant to Section 119 of the Election Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1988 Cap. E-1.

A Writ of Election was issued on the 19th day of February 1991 with polling day the 18th day of March 1991 to fill the vacant Assemblyman seat in the First Electoral District of Kings.

I am pleased to advise, Mr. Speaker, that democracy is alive and well because during the proxy period of this by-election which coincided with the Persian Gulf conflict one of 1st Kings residents (under Canadian Armed Forces Special Voting Rules) voted by proxy. A proxy form was forwarded to Bahrain in the Persian Gulf and the Canadian Armed Forces personnel signed his proxy in favor of his Mother. I received the signed proxy plus his Commanding Officer's certificate in plenty of time to enable the Returning Officer to issue the proxy certificate. The cooperation received from everyone involved in making this small incident a reality makes a person proud not only to be an Islander but also a Canadian.
