Re: Minor Injury Regulation

The purpose of this Bulletin is to provide information concerning the amendment to the minor injury amount, calculated in accordance with the *Minor Injury Regulation* (Regulation).

In accordance with the regulation, effective January 1, 2008, the minor injury amount of \$4,144 will be adjusted by 4.7 percent, to \$4,339. The new amount relates to minor injuries caused in motor vehicle accidents that occur on or after January 1, 2008.

The regulation requires an annual adjustment to the maximum total amount recoverable as damages for non-pecuniary loss for all minor injuries sustained by a claimant as a result of a motor vehicle accident. The annual adjustment is effective January 1 of each year. The amount of any adjustment is related to the annual change in the Alberta Consumer Price Index.
