## Revision made to Sexual Assault in Nova Scotia and Fact Sheet on Violence Against Women

Please note that we have made changes to the text accompanying Figure 1 in our recently released report, *Sexual Assault in Nova Scotia: A Statistical Portrait.* The change made pertains to the statistical significance of the provincial differences in sexual assault rates established by the 2004 *General Social Survey on Victimization.* While Nova Scotia's sexual assault rate appears to be higher than that of other provinces and higher than the national rate, none of these differences are statistically significant, with the exception of the difference between Nova Scotia's rate (40 per 1,000 population) and Québec's (11 per 1,000 population).
