## FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION ACT SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND REGULATIONS

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 9 November 1999.)

Pursuant to section 14.8 of the Financial Administration Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-9, as amended by Stats. P.E.I. 1999, (1st Sitting) c. 25, Council made the following regulations:

1. These regulations create programs as recommended by the Prince Purpose Edward Island Special Projects Fund Board to Executive Council pursuant to clause 14.5(b) of the Act for the disbursement of money from the following:
(a) Health Care Stabilization Fund;
(b) Development Fund;
(c) Health Research Fund;
(d) Waterway Protection Support Fund;
(e) Community Development Fund;
(f) Teacher Technology Training Fund.

## HEALTH CARE STABILIZATION FUND

2. (1) There is established a Health Care Support Program to be administered by the Department of Health and Social Services.
(2) The funds allocated to the Health Care Stabilization Fund shall be

Health Care Support Program

Purpose disbursed through the Health Care Support Program for the following purposes:
(a) to ensure existing programs and services are maintained;
(b) to stabilize the workforce through the conversion of casual and temporary positions to permanent positions;
(c) to address the difficulties in recruiting staff for speciality service delivery areas; and
(d) to maintain a high standard of health care delivery.
(3) Each regional authority continued pursuant to the Health and Criteria for Community Services Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-1.1 is eligible to apply eligibility to the Minister of Health and Social Services for funding from the Health Care Support Program.

3. (1) There is established an Economic Development Projects Program to be administered by the Department of Development.
(2) The funds allocated to the Development Fund shall be disbursed through the Economic Development Projects Program for the following purposes:
(a) funding economic development in the province; and
(b) enabling access to federal economic development assistance including, but not limited to, economic development agreements between the federal government and the province.
(3) Every project or program for which funding is being sought from the Economic Development Projects Program shall be consistent with the purposes prescribed in subsection (2).
(4) Where an application for the disbursement of an amount through the Economic Development Projects Program has been
(a) approved by the Minister of Development;
(b) approved by Treasury Board; and
(c) approved by Executive Council,
the Board shall disburse the approved amount.

## HEALTH RESEARCH FUND

4. (1) There is established a Health Research Program to be administered by the Department of Health and Social Services.
(2) The funds allocated to the Health Research Fund shall be disbursed through the Health Research Program for the purposes of
(a) providing new knowledge regarding persons suffering from diabetes, asthma, cancer, or other illnesses;
(b) providing information regarding health services and health systems;
(c) providing new knowledge regarding the prevention, early detection, and management of diabetes, asthma, cancer, or other illnesses; or
(d) assisting in determining best practices in the prevention and treatment of diabetes, asthma, cancer, or other illnesses.
(3) To be eligible for funding through the Health Research Program, research projects must meet the following criteria:
(a) be consistent with one of the purposes of the Health Research Program;
(b) demonstrate cooperation with relevant organizations at the local, provincial, national, or international level; and
(c) be presented in a form consistent with guidelines approved by the Board.
(4) Assessment of research project proposals made under the Health Research Program will give due consideration to the following priorities:
(a) cost-matching by another agency or organization;
(b) involvement of researchers based in the province; and
(c) providing economic benefit to the province.
(5) Research project proposals made under the Health Research Program may originate from public, private, or not-for-profit organizations.
(6) Where an application for the disbursement of an amount through the Health Research Program has been
(a) approved by the Minister of Health and Social Services;
(b) approved by Treasury Board; and
(c) approved by Executive Council,
the Board shall disburse the approved amount.

## WATERWAY PROTECTION SUPPORT FUND

5. (1) There is established an Agriculture and Environmental Resource Conservation Program to be administered by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry and the Department of Technology and Environment.
(2) Funds allocated to the Waterway Protection Support Fund may be disbursed through the Agriculture and Environmental Resource Conservation Program for the purposes of
(a) assisting farmers in the production of sustainable, high-quality crops and food products; and
(b) supporting and assisting farmers and owners of agricultural land in the compliance with legislation affecting their lands and operations.
(3) Where an application for the disbursement of an amount through the Agriculture and Environmental Resource Conservation Program has been
(a) approved by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry;
(b) approved by the Minister of Technology and Environment;
(c) approved by Treasury Board; and
(d) approved by Executive Council,

## Environmental and Natural Resource Program

Purpose and eligibility

Approval and disbursement
the Board shall disburse the approved amount.
(4) There is established an Environmental and Natural Resource Program to be administered by the Department of Technology and Environment.
(5) Funds allocated to the Waterway Protection Support Fund may be disbursed through the Environmental and Natural Resource Program for the purposes of
(a) providing assistance for undertakings intended to improve conservation of soil or water; and
(b) promotion of responsible and appropriate stewardship of the environment and natural resources.
(6) Where an application for the disbursement of an amount through the Environmental and Natural Resource Program has been
(a) approved by the Minister of Technology and Environment;
(b) approved by Treasury Board; and
(c) approved by Executive Council,
the Board shall disburse the approved amount.

## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND

6. (1) There is established a Community Development Program to be administered by the Department of Development.
(2) Funds allocated to the Community Development Fund shall be disbursed through the Community Development Program in order to enhance community life, infrastructure, and employment opportunities in areas including, but not limited to,
(a) education;
(b) technology;
(c) recreation; and
(d) environment.
(3) In order to be eligible for assistance from the Community Development Program, applicants shall be community organizations.
(4) Where an application for the disbursement of an amount through the Community Development Program has been
(a) approved by the Minister of Development, where the requested disbursement is less than $\$ 25,000$;
(b) approved by the Minister of Development, the Minister of Education, the Minister of Health and Social Services and the Minister of Technology and Environment, where the requested disbursement is greater than $\$ 25,000$;
(c) approved by Treasury Board; and
(d) approved by Executive Council,
the Board shall disburse the approved amount.

## TEACHER TECHNOLOGY TRAINING FUND

7. (1) There is established a Teacher Technology Training Program to be administered by the Department of Education.

Teacher Technology Training Program
(2) Funds allocated to the Teacher Technology Training Fund shall be disbursed through the Teacher Technology Training Program in order to promote and improve the use of technology in Island schools by
(a) providing training and support in technology to teachers;
(b) improving computer hardware and software in schools; or
(c) supporting the integration of technology into the curriculum.
(3) In order to be eligible for funding from the Teacher Technology Training Program, a proposed project shall

(4) Where an application for the disbursement of an amount from the Teacher Technology Training Program has been

(c) approved by Executive Council,
the Board shall disburse the approved amount.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 of these regulations states the purpose of these regulations, which is to create programs, as recommended by the Prince Edward Island Special Projects Fund Board to Executive Council, through which money may be disbursed from the Special Projects Fund established under the Financial Administration Act. The regulations also specify criteria for the disbursement of money under each program. Specifically:

SECTION 2 creates the Health Care Support Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Health and Social Services. Funds for this program will be drawn from the Health Care Stabilization Fund.

SECTION 3 creates the Economic Development Projects Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Development. Funds for this program will be drawn from the Development Fund.

SECTION 4 creates the Health Research Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Health and Social Services. Funds for this program will be drawn from the Health Research Fund.

SECTION 5 creates the Agriculture and Environmental Resource Conservation Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry and the Department of Technology and Environment, and the Environmental and Natural Resource Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Technology and Environment. Funds for these programs will be drawn from the Waterway Protection Support Fund.

SECTION 6 creates the Community Development Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Development. Funds for this program will be drawn from the Community Development Fund.

SECTION 7 creates the Teacher Technology Training Program, which is to be administered by the Department of Education. Funds for this Program will be disbursed through the Teacher Technology Training Fund.

SECTION 8 is a commencement section.

## 1. The Lands Protection Act Exemption Regulations (EC368/88) are amended by the addition of the following:

Summerside Golf Club Inc.
22. (1) The following properties, located in the City of Summerside and totalling approximately 148.51 acres, are exempt from the application of the Act:
(a) approximately 1.01 acres, being Provincial Property Number 649871;
(b) approximately 2.69 acres subdivided from Provincial Property Number 65326;
(c) approximately 134.97 acres subdivided from Provincial Property Number 65508;
(d) approximately 2.69 acres subdivided from Provincial Property Number 445973;
(e) approximately 1.76 acres subdivided from Provincial Property Number 460576;
(f) approximately 5.39 acres, being a portion of the Duck Pond Road.
(2) Subsection (1) shall cease to have effect

Condition
(a) if any part of the property is used for any purpose other than a golf course; or
(b) if any of the properties are conveyed by Summerside Golf Club Inc.
without the prior approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
2. These regulations come into force on November 9, 1999.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

These regulations exempt those properties comprising the Summerside Golf Course from the provisions of the Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act.

Pursuant to section 8 of the Liquor Control Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L14, Council made the following regulations:

1. The Liquor Control Act Regulations (EC704/75) are amended by the addition of the following:
30.1 (1) No person shall subdivide premises which are the subject of a lounge license for the purpose of applying for any additional liquor license or licenses for the area already subject to the lounge license.
(2) The commission shall not issue any additional liquor license or licenses for all or part of any premises which are the subject of a lounge license.
40.1 (1) No person shall subdivide premises which are the subject of a club license for the purpose of applying for any additional liquor license or licenses for the area already subject to the club license.
(2) The commission shall not issue any additional liquor license for all or part of any premises which are the subject of a club license.
50.01 (1) No person shall subdivide premises which are the subject of a military canteen license for the purpose of applying for additional liquor licenses for the area already subject to the military canteen license.
(2) The commission shall not issue any additional liquor license or licenses for all or part of any premises which are the subject of a military canteen license.

## 2. Section 50.1 of the regulations is amended by the addition of the following:

(5) No person shall subdivide premises which are the subject of a special premises license for the purpose of applying for additional liquor licenses for the area already subject to the special premises license.
(6) The commission shall not issue any additional liquor license or licenses for all or part of any premises which are the subject of a special premises license.
3. These regulations come into force on November 20, 1999.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

These amendments prohibit existing licensed premises from being subdivided in order to apply for more than one license for the same premises.
