**HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT**  
**DEMERIT POINT SYSTEM REGULATIONS**  
**AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 26 June 2001.)

Pursuant to section 284 of the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5, Council made the following regulations:

**1. The Schedule to the *Highway Traffic Act* Demerit Point System Regulations (EC1216/80) is amended by the addition of the following in the appropriate columns:**

4a	Section 249.1(1) of the Criminal Code	12	Flight from peace officer
4b	Section 249.1(3) of the Criminal Code	12	Flight from peace officer causing bodily harm

**2. These regulations come into force on July 7, 2001.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

The amendments show new offences added to the Criminal Code (Canada) for which 12 points will be assessed.
