EFFECTIVE: February 1, 2003

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap N-3, the Prince Edward Island Marketing Council makes the following Order:

CLASS 1 MILK PRICE DETERMINATION ORDER

1. This Order provides for the establishment of the price of milk components paid to the Prince Edward Island Milk Marketing Board for components sold as Class 1 products. Also, this Order provides for the establishment of the minimum wholesale and home delivery prices for Class 1 milk products.
2. The milk classifications that apply in sections 3, 4, and 5 of this Order shall be established by the Prince Edward Island Milk Marketing Board, by Order of the Classification of Milk Order No. MMB00-04.
3. The price of milk components paid to the Prince Edward Island Milk Marketing Board by processors for components sold in Class 1(a) products shall be \$6.3676 per kilogram of butterfat, \$5.2445 per kilogram of protein and \$5.2445 per kilogram of other solids. The Prince Edward Island Milk Marketing Board shall use a standard component test value of 3.3999 kilograms per hectolitre for protein and 5.7423 kilograms per hectoliter of other solids for billing purposes.
4.
