PRICE DETERMINATION ORDER - AMENDMENT

1. This Order amends the prices contained in Section 4 of Board Order 86-7.

3. (a) Each producer who delivers milk in Prince Edward Island shall pay to the Board a levy of \$0.1184 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk delivered by him for general administration of the Board.

(b) Each producer who delivers milk in Prince Edward Island shall pay to the Board a levy of \$0.2837 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk delivered by him for product promotion.

Each cream producer who delivers farm separated cream to a plant in Prince Edward Island shall pay to the Board a levy of \$0.095 per kilogram of butterfat delivered by him that is within the Quota fixed and allotted to him. This levy includes \$0.04 per kilogram of butterfat for general administration of the Board and \$0.055 per kilogram of butterfat for product promotion.

Over quota levies:

5. Each producer who delivers farm separated cream in excess of the Quota fixed and allotted to him shall pay to the Board a levy of \$4.405 per kilogram of butterfat that is in excess of the Quota fixed and allotted to him. This levy includes \$4.31 per kilogram of butterfat for disposal of surplus product, \$0.04 per kilogram of butterfat for general administration of the Board and \$0.055 per kilogram of butterfat for product promotion.

6. Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Order # 2004-03, dated the 1st day of August 2004, is hereby revoked.

7. This Order comes into force 1 December 2004.

5. Subsection 14(1) of the regulations is amended by the addition of the words “or a valid HHI license” after the words “HHI license”.

6. Subsection 14(3) of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words “Form 6” and the substitution of the words “Form 6B”.

7. Form 6 of the Schedule to the regulations is revoked and the Forms as set out in the Schedule to these regulations are substituted.

8. These regulations come into force on December 4, 2004.

(1) The Minister may issue a snowshoe hare snaring license to an applicant who <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) makes an application on a form approved by the Minister; (b) is at least 12 years of age; (c) pays the prescribed fee set out in subsection (6); and (d) is not precluded from making an application under subsection (2).
License suspended	(2) A person whose current license is suspended under subsection 31(2) of the Act may not make an application for a new license under subsection (1) until the suspension has expired.
Duration	(3) A license expires on March 31 following the date the license was issued.

- (4) A license authorizes the holder, during the term of the license, to snare snowshoe hares, subject to the Act and these regulations. Authorization to snare
- (5) No person shall snare or attempt to snare snowshoe hare unless the person holds a snowshoe hare snaring license. Prohibition
- (6) The prescribed fee payable for a license application is \$4.77. Prescribed fee
3. (1) No person shall set a snare for snowshoe hare unless the snare is made of a single strand of copper or brass wire, commonly known as rabbit wire, that is of between 22 and 24 gauge. Wire gauge
- (2) No person shall set a snare for snowshoe hare with a wire loop greater than 10 cm (4 inches) in diameter. Wire loop
4. The open season, daily limits and possession limits in respect of the snaring of snowshoe hare are as follows: Open season, limits, possession

5. These regulations come into force on December 4, 2004. Commencement

EXPLANATORY NOTES

These regulations prohibit the snaring of snowshoe hares without a snowshoe hare snaring license. These regulations also set out restrictions on the construction of snares used in respect of snowshoe hares and establish the open season for snaring snowshoe hares.
