

Under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N-3 and the Prince Edward Island Egg Commodity Marketing Regulations thereunder, the Egg Producers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

## SOURCING OF EGGS FOR THE TABLE MARKET

- Application 1. This Order is issued for the purpose of ensuring that, to the extent possible, eggs produced on Prince Edward Island that are of sufficient quality and grade are made available for sale in the Prince Edward Island shell egg table market in compliance with the Industrial Product Program entered into by the Board with the Canadian Egg Marketing Agency.
- Definitions 2. The words herein shall have the meaning as found in the *Natural Products Marketing Act* and the Egg Commodity Marketing Regulations unless differentiated herein as hereinafter defined:
  - (a) "Board" means the Egg Producers of Prince Edward Island;
  - (b) "CEMA" means the Canadian Egg Marketing Agency;

(c) "COP" means a Prince Edward Island egg producer's cost of producing eggs determined by utilizing a cost of production formula, for Prince Edward Island, maintained by CEMA;

(d) "declared eggs" are eggs offered for sale to the Board by a grading station, which are surplus to the grading station's shell egg table market needs;

(e) "grading station" means a facility that purchases eggs from egg producers for the purpose of marketing eggs;

(f) "industrial product" means eggs surplus to the shell egg table market in the Province of Prince Edward Island that may be utilized for industrial purposes through the Industrial Product Program;

(g) "Industrial Product Program" means a program for the removal of eggs surplus to the shell egg table market of Prince Edward Island pursuant to an agreement between the Board and CEMA;

(h) "nest run" means eggs sold by a grading station that have not been graded prior to sale;

(i) "pencil grade-out" means a grading of eggs by a grading station, declared to the Board as nest run eggs, where the grading is by a sample grade-out or estimation and not by actually grading as specified by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency; (i) "stabilization payments" means payments made by the Board to grading stations pursuant to the Board's Stabilization Payments for Industrial Product Order. 3. The Board may purchase eggs from grading stations for the purpose of ensuring eggs produced on Prince Edward Island are available to supply the Prince Edward Island shell egg table market provided the Nest Run Eggs Fund maintained by the Board has or will have funds available in that fiscal period. 4. The Board may purchase eggs as industrial product only from grading stations that hold a current federal license issued by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency and grading stations that are approved by the Board. 5. Grading stations that declare industrial product eggs that are nest run and graded on a pencil grade-out and purchased by the Board shall be purchased on the basis of COP plus stabilization payments. Orders for eggs 6. Grading stations that wish to order nest run eggs from the Board must do so on an approved form by 4:00 pm on Friday of the week before the eggs are required or on the previous business day where Friday is a holiday. Late orders will not be accepted by the Board. The grading station purchasing the eggs will purchase the declared nest run eggs on the same price basis as the week of declaration. Nest run eggs 7. The weight of nest run eggs per box of 15 dozen eggs, used for declaration purposes, are: 16-17, 17-18, 18-19, 19-20, 20-21, 21-22, 22-23, 23-24, 24-25, 25+Lbs. Idem 8. Nest run classes for the purposes of this Order shall be: Class 1 - <19 Lbs - Not eligible for grading Class 2 - 19-22 Lbs - Eligible for grading into Canada Grade A Medium Class 3 - >22 Lbs - Eligible for grading into Canada Grade A Large Classes Ordered 9. A grading station ordering nest run eggs shall indicate the nest run class required. Classes are described above. Orders must be placed in normal pallet lots of either 60 or 48 boxes per pallet. Declarations 10. Grading stations shall declare their industrial product eggs to the Board no later than 12:00 noon on Monday of each week or on the next business day where Monday is a holiday. Declarations received after 12:00 noon may be rejected. The Board may purchase some or all of the declared nest run industrial product eggs from declaring grading stations prior to declaring nest run industrial product eggs to CEMA if the Board has received an order from a purchasing grading station as

provided for under section 6.

Summary of available eggs 11. By 2:00 pm on each Monday afternoon or on the next business day where Monday is a holiday, the Board will provide purchasing grading stations with a summary of nest run eggs declared to the Board and the eggs to be purchased by the Board. By 4:00 pm on each Monday afternoon or on the next business day where Monday is a holiday, the purchasing grading station shall confirm the purchase of the nest run eggs from the Board. 12. The Board will determine which nest run eggs are sold to the purchasing grading station based on the following criteria: a) declaring grading station gradeout b) age of producer flock c) shell quality d) quantity ordered/declared 13. A purchasing grading station ordering eggs from the Board is required to pick up, grade and provide an actual gradeout of the eggs to the Board within 10 days of placing the order. 14. A grading station may purchase from the Board some or all of the eggs purchased by the Board for industrial product as provided for in section 4 at a cost of COP plus stabilization payments based on the actual grade-out. If, based on COP, the cost per dozen of the pencil grade-out exceeds the cost per dozen of the actual grade-out by more than \$0.05 per dozen, then the grading station that declared the nest run eggs to the Board on the basis of a pencil grade-out shall only be permitted to declare further eggs to the Board if the eggs pass a Canada nest run inspection by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency, unless the Board has indicated to the grading station that it intends to declare the eggs as nest run to CEMA. 15. If a Canada nest run inspection conducted by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency indicates that the total under grades exceed an additional 5% of the current pencil grade-out then the grading station declaring eggs to the Board shall be responsible for the costs of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency Canada nest run inspection. If the Canada nest run inspection conducted by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency indicates that the total under grades do not exceed an additional 5% of the current pencil grade-out of the declaring grading station, then the purchasing grading station shall be responsible for the costs of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency Canada nest run inspection. Return of Supplies 16. The grading station purchasing eggs under this Order shall be responsible for the cost of the eggs purchased and for all pick-up/delivery costs and for the return of supplies to the declaring grading station where the declaring grading station provides pallets, fillers and dividers. Supplies shall be returned in a reasonable condition to the declaring grading station in a timely manner. Payment Terms 17. Payment terms for the declaring grading station shall be the same as the terms under the Industrial Product Program.
