Under the Prince Edward Island Egg Commodity Marketing Regulations and the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I.1988, Cap. N-3, the Egg Producers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

#### AMENDMENT TO BOARD ORDER ECMB 88-2

Application

 This Order amends the levy rate contained in Subsection 6(a) of Board Order 88-2.

Levy rate Amended

- 2. Subsection 6(a) of Board Order 88-2 is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:
  - 6.(a) A levy charge on ungraded eggs shall be levied annually by the Board on the producers, subject to change by the Board, and the charge shall be based on a producer's allocated quota at the rate of thirty-three point zero cents (\$0.330) per dozen eggs and it is established that the minimum number of eggs per bird shall be, in the case of leghorns and dual purpose birds, twenty four point nine, nine (24.99) dozen eggs per annum except that during a year that has fifty-three (53) weeks the minimum number of eggs per bird shall be twenty-five point four seven (25.47) dozen eggs per annum.

Commencement

3. This Order shall come into force on the 17th day of June, 2007.

#### PLANNING ACT SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT REVOCATION
