

Applications Invited Nova Scotia Arts and Culture Partnership Council

Applications are invited from volunteers interested in serving on a new Nova Scotia Arts and Culture Partnership Council. The council has been established to address the challenges and opportunities that face the arts and culture in the province. Its mandate is to make recommendations to the Minister of Tourism and Culture on the planning, design and delivery of arts and culture programs in Nova Scotia.

The council will include 13 sector leaders and two government representatives. A culturesector led selection committee will make recommendations to the Minister and will work to:

- strike a balance between the arts and cultural industries
- strike a balance between artists and arts organizations
- address regional and cultural diversity
- address the necessity to have a wide range of experience among council members, and
- represent a diversity of culture sub-sectors.
