1	Statute	C. 8, S. 3(1) of Statutes of Nova Scotia 1991, the <i>University Foundations Act</i>
2	Purpose	The Foundation was established as a corporation under the <i>University Foundations Act</i> . Through the development of private support its purpose is to increase and enhance public knowledge and awareness of the Nova Scotia Agricultural College, its values and mission.
3	Function	The Foundation is mandated to receive and manage donations and gifts in support of the College, its programs, students, facilities and activities pursuant to the <i>University Foundations Act</i> .
4	Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 members appointed by the Governor in Council - 2 members appointed by the Governor in Council from a list of 5 persons who are members of, and are nominated by, that body of persons who have the management and control of the affairs of the designated university for which the foundation is established or who constitute the designated university.
5	Formal Qualifications	Two members are Board of Governors members.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	
7	Skills Required	Ability to commit time and effort to the work of the Foundation and the Agricultural College. Should have experience with fundraising, organizational management, community-related organizations, or investment management; have a special interest in the university and the university community.
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	Section 5 (1) (b) Two members appointed from a list of five persons who are members of, and are nominated by, that body of persons who have the management and control of the affairs of the designated university for which the foundation is established or who constitute the designated university.

9	Term of Appointment	determined by Governor in Council; may be reappointed; cannot serve more than 6 consecutive years.
