Supplier Debriefing - It's All About You!

This is a service offered to any supplier when requested within ten days of a tender award. The debriefing should be a positive and constructive experience that explains how you may improve future submissions.

WHAT IT IS

It's an opportunity for suppliers to:

- learn more about the procurement and evaluation process in an informal setting.
- find out how <u>your</u> proposal scored against the published criteria.
- hear overall comments from the evaluation team on your bid.
- gather information on how future submissions may be improved.

WHAT IT IS NOT

- It is not part of the Vendor Complaint Process which can be found at:

- It is not a legal proceeding, so no legal representation is permitted.
- It is not the venue to talk about other bidders. Your bid is not compared to other bids, nor will information be provided about other bids.*
