#### **CHAPTER A-11.1**

# ANIMAL HEALTH AND PROTECTION ACT

#### ANIMAL HEALTH REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 7 of the Animal Health and Protection Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. A-11.1, Council made the following regulations:

## 1. In these regulations

Definitions

- (a) to (f) revoked by EC154/05;
- (g) "vehicle" means any vehicle used for the transporting of animals. vehicle (EC193/91; 154/05)

### 2. Revoked by EC154/05.

Named diseases

3. (1) The owner of any animal, a veterinarian and any other person Notification to having custody of an animal, who suspects that any animal is suffering from a named disease shall forthwith notify the Provincial Veterinarian.

Provincial Veterinarian

Powers

- (2) Where the Provincial Veterinarian receives a notification pursuant to subsection (1), he may
  - (a) authorize an inspector to make an inspection;
  - (b) take all steps that he considers necessary for the suppression and control of an outbreak of the disease. (EC193/91)
- **4.** Subsections (1) to (7) revoked by EC154/05.

Inspector, power of

- (8) An inspector may take any measures that he may consider Remedial measures advisable for the suppression or limitation of an outbreak of disease. (EC193/91; 154/05)
- **5.** Revoked by EC154/05.

Restricted area

**6.** (1) Where an order of an inspector is made under subsections 3.2(2) Restriction on of the Act is posted on a premises, no person shall, without the approval of the inspector,

transportation of animal or animal by-product

- (a) allow the transportation of, or transport, an animal or an animal by-product from the premises; or
- (b) allow an animal or animal by-product to be transported, or transport an animal or by-product, to the premises.
- (2) Any person who drives or operates a vehicle used for the Disinfection transportation of an animal or animal by-product to a farm or premises on which an order made under subsection 3.2(2) of the Act is posted

shall, after the transportation is completed, ensure that the vehicle is disinfected in a manner acceptable to the inspector. (EC193/91; 154/05)

**7.** Revoked by EC154/05.

Testing animal byproduct, hay, etc.

- **8.** Where an animal is infected with, or an inspector believes on reasonable grounds that the animal is infected with, a named disease, the inspector may, inspect and take samples from
  - (a) any animal by-product of the animal; and
  - (b) any hay, straw, fodder, litter or other item that the inspector believes on reasonable grounds came into contact with, or may have come into contact with, the animal. (EC193/91; 154/05)
