## **CHAPTER D-4**

### **DAY OF REST ACT**

#### **EXEMPTION REGULATIONS**

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Day of Rest Act*  
R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. D-4

**1.** Section 3 of the *Day of Rest Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. D-4 does not Exemptions  
apply in respect of the operation or conduct of the following activities:

- (a) the holding of “open houses” for the purpose of showing real estate to potential purchasers;
- (b) the holding of “craft fairs” by the Prince Edward Island Crafts Council for the purpose of showing and offering for sale to the public hand-made craft and gift items. (EC578/85; 237/87)
