CHAPTER F-7

FENCES AND DETENTION OF STRAY LIVESTOCK ACT

REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 10 of the Fences and Detention of Stray Livestock Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-7, Council made the following regulations:

1. The certificate of costs issued pursuant to subsection 3(6) of the Act Certificate of costs shall be in Form 1 of the Schedule. (EC495/87)

2. The order of the fence viewer issued pursuant to subsection 4(3) of the Order Act shall be in Form 2 of the Schedule. (EC495/87)

3. The minimum requirements for the design, dimensions and materials Requirements for of fences required to be built or repaired under the provisions of the Act fences shall be as follows:

(a) all fence posts shall be spaced no more than 15 feet apart unless wood stakes support the wire between the fence posts, in which case the fence posts may be spaced not more than 22 feet apart;

(b) all fence posts shall be embedded into the ground a minimum of 2 feet 6 inches and shall extend not less than 4 feet above the ground;

(c) all fence posts shall be either wood posts or steel T-bar fence posts;

(d) where wood posts are used, the posts shall be structurally sound and shall have a diameter of not less than 4 inches;

(e) where wood stakes are used in addition to posts, the wood stakes shall be structurally sound and shall have a diameter of not less than 2 inches;

(f) fencing material shall consist of one of the following materials:

(i) barbed wire,

(ii) energized electric wire,

(iii) commercially woven wire, or

(iv) high tensile smooth wire;

(g) where barbed wire is used, there shall be 3 strands of barbed wire, each strand fastened securely to each fence post, and the top strand of barbed wire shall be located on the fence posts not less than 3 feet 6 inches from the ground and the bottom strand of barbed wire shall be located not less than 1 foot from the ground;

(h) where energized electric wire is used, there shall be 2 strands of energized electric wire so located that any livestock challenging the fence would receive a shock to the face or ears of the livestock;

(i) where commercially woven wire fencing is used, the top edge of the woven wire fencing shall be located not less than 3 feet 6 inches above the ground and the woven wire fencing shall be fastened securely to each fence post;

(j) where high tensile smooth wire fence is used, there shall be 5 strands of smooth wire with a 300 pound tension, each strand shall be fastened securely to each fence post, and the top strand of high tensile smooth wire shall be located on the fence posts not less than 3 feet 6 inches from the ground and the bottom strand of high tensile smooth wire shall be located not less than 1 foot from the ground. (EC495/87)

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3, other fencing materials may be used in substitution, providing these materials are equivalent to or in excess of the specifications contained in section 3 and providing there is agreement between the adjacent landowners and the fence viewer on the use of such materials. (EC495/87)
