CHAPTER H-5

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT

DESIGNATION OF URBAN AND BUSINESS DISTRICTS REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5

1. That section of a highway wherein a maximum speed limit of fifty kilometers per hour is indicated by the erection or existence of a sign at each end of such section of the highway and facing the stream of traffic entering such section of the highway, is designated as an urban district. (EC225/65; 1039/77) Urban districts

2. That section of a highway wherein a maximum speed limit of sixty kilometers per hour is indicated by the erection or existence of a sign at each end of the section of the highway and facing the stream of traffic entering the section of the highway is designated as a business district. (EC225/65; 1039/77) Business districts
