CHAPTER H-5

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT

PROVINCIALLY APPROVED SCREENING DEVICES REGULATIONS

Pursuant to subsection 69(1) of the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5, Council made the following regulations:

1. For the purposes of section 277.9 of the *Highway Traffic Act* Provincially R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5, the following devices are prescribed as provincially approved screening devices and approved instruments:

- (a) Approved Screening Devices
 - (i) Alcolmeter S-L2,
 - (ii) Alcotest ™ 7410 PA3,
 - (iii) Alcotest ™ 7410 GLC;
- (b) Approved Instruments
 - (i) Breathalyzer ™, Model 900,
 - (ii) Breathalyzer ™, Model 900A,
 - (iii) BAC Datamaster C. (EC226/07)
