## **CHAPTER I-4**

## INSURANCE ACT

## FEES REGULATIONS

Pursuant to sections 83 and 84 of the *Insurance Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-4, Council made the following regulations:

1.	The following fees are prescribed:	Fees
	(a) license for an insurer, for a one-year term\$900	
	(b) certificate of authority for an agent,	
	for a two-year term\$200	
	(c) full or probationary license for an adjuster,	
	for a two-year term\$200	
	(d) transfer of a license of an agent or adjuster\$ 50	
	(e) insurance exam\$ 50	
	(f) letter of good standing\$ 25	
	(g) copy of a certificate of authority\$ 25
