**CHAPTER I-4**  
**INSURANCE ACT**  
**FEES REGULATIONS**

Pursuant to sections 83 and 84 of the *Insurance Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-4, Council made the following regulations:

1. The following fees are prescribed: Fees
- (a) license for an insurer, for a one-year term.....\$900
  - (b) certificate of authority for an agent,  
for a two-year term.....\$200
  - (c) full or probationary license for an adjuster,  
for a two-year term.....\$200
  - (d) transfer of a license of an agent or adjuster.....\$ 50
  - (e) insurance exam .....\$ 50
  - (f) letter of good standing .....\$ 25
  - (g) copy of a certificate of authority .....\$ 25

2. The *Insurance Act* Fees Regulations (EC42/97) and the License Fees Revocation  
for Insurers Regulations (EC257/75) are revoked. (EC246/05)
