#### **CHAPTER L-12**

#### LIGHTNING ROD ACT

#### REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the Lightning Rod Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-12

#### 1. In these regulations

Definitions

- (a) "approved" as it refers to material and equipment means that approved such material and equipment used in a lightning rod system has been examined by the Chief Electrical Inspector and is considered by him to be acceptable for the intended use;
- (b) "Code" means the Canadian Standards Association Standard B Code 72 1960 Code for the installation of lightning rods and such amendments, additions, or deletions thereto or subsequent editions thereof as are approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- (c) "disconnector" means an approved device or fitting which is disconnector installed in grounding conductors attached to ground electrodes and serves as a means of disconnecting a grounding conductor in testing grounding electrodes. (EC583/72)
- 2. Except as provided in these regulations the standards which govern the Application of CSA design, installation, maintenance, alteration, and repair of lightning rod Standards Code systems shall be those set forth in the Code. (EC583/72)

3. The guarantee agreement required by subsection 8(2) of the Lightning Guarantee *Rod Act* shall contain the clauses included in Form 1 of the Appendix A. (EC583/72)

- 4. (1) Every firm which is eligible to obtain a license under the Act and Bond regulations shall file a bond in the amount of five thousand dollars with the Provincial Treasurer as required by subsection 8(3) of the Act.
- (2) The bond shall be filed by the firm or supply firm upon receipt of *Idem* notice from the Chief Electrical Inspector approving the application for a license, and no license shall be issued pursuant to the Act until the bond is filed with the Provincial Treasurer.
- (3) The bond shall contain the clauses included in Form 2 of Appendix A. (EC583/72; 105/84; 484/86; 639/93)
- **5.** (1) An applicant for a salesman's license shall

- (a) satisfy the Chief Electrical Inspector that he possesses a thorough knowledge of the lightning rod system that he proposes to sell;
- (b) be examined by the Chief Electrical Inspector on the applicant's knowledge of the *Lightning Rod Act* and regulations and on his knowledge of the materials associated with the lightning rod system.

Mechanic's license

- (2) An applicant for a mechanic's license shall
  - (a) provide the Chief Electrical Inspector with a letter of recommendation from his employer;
  - (b) show proof that he has worked as a mechanic's helper for at least two years;
  - (c) be examined by the Chief Electrical Inspector with respect to his workmanship relating to lightning rod systems and his knowledge of the Code

Issue of licenses

(3) The Chief Electrical Inspector may issue the applicant a salesman's license or a mechanic's license if he is satisfied that the applicant meets all the requirements of subsection (1) for a salesman's license, and the requirements of subsection (2) for a mechanic's license. (EC583/72)

Materials and equipment

**7.** The types of materials and equipment used in lightning rod systems shall meet the requirements of the Code, and shall be approved by the Chief Electrical Inspector, and where in the opinion of the Chief Electrical Inspector the materials are not adequate, notwithstanding compliance by such materials with the Code, the materials shall not be used until they meet such additional requirements as may be prescribed by the Chief Electrical Inspector. (EC583/72)

Disconnectors

**8.** Disconnectors for testing ground electrodes shall be installed in each grounding conductor at approximately three feet above grade or at such height as is practical for access thereto. (EC583/72)

Special installation

**9.** (1) Where provisions respecting the installation of a lightning rod system or part thereof are not contained in the Code, the firm installing such lightning rod system shall notify the Chief Electrical Inspector of

the matter for which no provision is made in the Code prior to installing such lightning rod system.

- (2) Every installation or part thereof for which no specific provision is made in the Code shall be subject to the approval of the Chief Electrical Inspector prior to the installation of the lightning rod system, and where such installation is not approved by the Chief Electrical Inspector, the firm installing such lightning rod system shall make such alterations thereto as may be prescribed by the Chief Electrical Inspector. (EC583/72)
- **10.** (1) Upon completion of each and every installation of a lightning rod certificates system in whole or in part or as an addition or repair to an existing installation, a certificate shall be properly filled out by the firm and duly signed by the firm and the owner.

(2) The certificate shall include the clauses shown in Form 10 of Form Appendix A.

(3) The original copy of the certificate shall, upon completion of an Copy to inspector installation be sent forthwith to the office of the Chief Electrical Inspector by the firm installing the lightning rod system.

(4) The duplicate copy shall be delivered to the party for whom the Copy to owner installation was made.

(5) The triplicate copy shall be retained by the firm.

Copy retained

- (6) If a certificate is spoiled it shall not be destroyed but marked void Spoiled certificate and forwarded to the Chief Electrical Inspector.
- (7) A certificate shall be completed for each building or buildings Separate certificate equipped. (EC583/72)
- **11.** (1) The following fees shall be payable by an applicant for the Fees following licenses:

(a) Firm License\$	140.00
(b) Supply Firm License\$	140.00
(c) Salesman License\$	10.00
(d) Mechanic License\$	10.00

- (2) The following fees shall be payable by a firm for inspections Inspection fees conducted by the Chief Electrical Inspector:
  - (a) twenty-five (25) cents per foot of cable installed;
  - (b) the amount of the fee specified in clause (a) shall be forwarded by the firm to the office of the Chief Electrical Inspector prior to December 31 of the year in which a firm license is issued and prior to renewal of such license. A sworn statement indicating the number

of feet of conductor that was installed during the year in which the license was valid shall accompany the payment.

Special inspections

(3) A charge for special inspections shall be at the rate of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per half hour plus travelling expenses and the minimum charge for any inspection shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00) and such charges shall be payable by the owner or the installer.

(4) All payments being payable hereunder shall be made to the Provincial Treasurer. (EC670/95)

#### Appendix A Form 1

#### **GUARANTEE AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT made BETWEEN:
(hereinafter referred to as "the firm")
OF THE ONE PART
AND:
(hereinafter referred to as "the purchaser")

#### OF THE OTHER PART

WHEREAS the purchaser has purchased from the firm a lightning rod system being more particularly described in Schedule A hereto annexed and forming part of this agreement and the firm has installed the said lightning rod system on buildings being more particularly described in Schedule B hereto annexed and forming part of this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of the sum of ...... being the consideration paid by the purchaser to the

firm for the said lightning rod system and installation thereof, and in consideration of the terms, and conditions herein contained, the parties hereto covenant and agree each for itself, its successors and assigns as follows:

- THAT the firm hereby guarantees that the lightning rod system will protect the buildings against damage caused by lightning for a period of five years commencing on the date hereof.
- 2. THAT the firm hereby guarantees that in the event damage is caused to the said buildings, the firm shall refund to the purchaser the consideration hereinabove referred to if the damage to the lightning rod system shall amount to such consideration and if such damage to the lightning rod system does not amount to so much, the firm shall, at its own cost and expense make all such repairs which may be necessary to the lightning rod system to render it fully operational.
- 3. THAT it is understood and agreed by the purchaser that the purchaser, his heirs, administrators, executors, successors, and assigns shall at no time allow the lightning rod system to be removed or displaced, or the direct ground connection broken by any person other than the firm or the Chief Electrical Inspector of Prince Edward Island or their duly authorized agents without the consent in writing of the firm being first obtained.
- 4. THAT in the event of any damage by lightning to the said building notice in writing must be given by the purchaser to the firm at their office within thirty days of the date of such damage, containing a full and detailed statement of the cause and amount of damage and facts relating thereto in the form of a statutory declaration, and in the event such notice is not given within thirty days, this guarantee shall be void.

- 5. THAT it is further understood by the purchaser that this guarantee agreement shall not extend to damage sustained by lightning conducted over or through any other building connected with the said building and unprotected by the lightning rod system or from any addition thereafter made to the building and so unprotected, and nor will this guarantee agreement extend to buildings furnished in part with other systems not manufactured or installed by the firm.
- 6. THAT the firm may examine the lightning rod system and inspect the lightning rod system at such time or times as it may deem advisable, and with or without the consent of the purchaser being first obtained.
- 7. THAT this guarantee agreement on its termination will be extended by a continuation agreement containing the terms and conditions of this guarantee agreement for a period of five years at the written request of the purchaser, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors, or assigns providing always that the buildings and the lightning rod system are, in the opinion of the firm, in good state of repair at the expiration of the first five year period, and without extra cost to the purchaser, subject however to an inspection fee chargeable by the firm and payable by the purchaser and not exceeding the sum of fifty dollars.
