## **CHAPTER P-24**

## PROVINCIAL BUILDING CODE ACT

## THERMAL INSULATION REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the Provincial Building Code Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-24

- 1. This regulation applies to the thermal insulation of all new residential Application buildings intended for use on a continuing basis. (EC550/76)
- 2. Thermal insulation of all new residential buildings intended for use on Insulation a continuing basis shall be as follows:
  - requirement for new residential buildings (a) thermal insulation in all ceilings shall have an R value of 20;
  - (b) thermal insulation in all walls shall have an R value of 10. (EC550/76)
