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CHAPTER P-30

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT

DISINTERMENT OF HUMAN REMAINS REGULATIONS

Pursuant to clause 23(e) of the *Public Health Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-30 Council made the following regulations:

1. Except where a disinterment of human remains is ordered by a coroner, the Supreme Court or the Attorney General, no person shall disinter human remains unless he first obtains a disinterment permit. (EC562/82; 639/93) Permit required, exception
2. An application for a permit shall be made to the Chief Health Officer and shall provide such information as he may require. (EC562/82) Application for permit
3. The Chief Health Officer may issue a permit. (EC562/82) Issue
4. Where a permit is issued under section 3 or where a disinterment of human remains is otherwise ordered under the authority of an enactment, the Chief Health Officer shall give such directions as he may determine respecting the disinterment, transportation, storage and reinterment of the human remains. (EC562/82) Directions of Chief Health Officer
5. Nothing in these regulations affects the requirements for a burial permit under the *Vital Statistics Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. V-4. (EC562/82) Requirements of Vital Statistics Act
