**SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS ACT
TICKET REGULATIONS
AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to subsection 10(3) of the *Summary Proceedings Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. S-9, Council made the following regulations:

1. Schedule 1 of the *Summary Proceedings Act* Ticket Regulations (EC321/01) is amended

(a) by the deletion of the words “\$ 10.00” wherever they occur and the substitution of the words “\$ 20.00”; and

(b) on the reverse side of the SUMMONS TO ACCUSED, by the deletion of the words “PROVINCIAL/YOUTH COURT COUR PROVINCIALE/TRIBUNAL POUR ADOLESCENTS 15 GREEN STREET SOURIS, P.E.I. C0A 2B0 TEL: (902) 687-7075”.

2. These regulations come into force on September 1, 2004.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The amendments to Schedule 1 increase the victim surcharge from \$10.00 to \$20.00 and remove references to the Souris Court House as no Justice of the Peace is available at that location.
