EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ACT  
 ATTORNEY GENERAL  
 AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT  
 (PROJECT FUNDING AGREEMENT – VICTIMS FUND)  
 WITH THE  
 GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

Pursuant to clause 10(a) of the *Executive Council Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-12 Council authorized the Attorney General to enter into an agreement with the Government of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Justice, to set out the terms of renewed project funding under the Victims Fund to enhance victim services in Prince Edward Island for the period 1 November 2005 to 31 March 2010, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.
