The Crops and Livestock Research Center has expertise in conducting research for the agriculture and related industries on potato management and feed crops, specifically in cereal and forage crops; management, protection and nutrition of potatoes; soil management and conservation; and feeding and nutrition of swine and beef animals. The center serves as the national center of excellence for sustainable potato production systems.

The Research Center develops improved technologies for crop production that reduces use of chemical pesticides and fertilizers; reduces soil erosion in potato production; makes better use of on-farm or municipal waste by conversion to usable composts for crop production; and develops improved soil management technologies to conserve the soil resource.

Projects undertaken:

- < crop management of potatoes and feed crops
- < pest management in cropping systems
- < development of cereal and clover varieties
- < soil erosion control in agricultural systems
- < conservation tillage and soil quality
- < crop residue management in cropping systems
- < management of nitrate in agricultural soils
- < composting of agricultural and industry wastes
- < beef cattle and swine nutrition

The Research Center operates with a total budget of \$5.6 million and has approximately \$0.5 million additional in Matching Investment Initiative (MII) projects, with 85 full-time staff, including 21 researchers. The center's laboratory building at the Home Farm also houses staff of the Agriculture Division of the PEI Department of Agriculture and Forestry; the Atlantic regional and PEI district offices of Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's Market and Industry Services Branch. The center operates two other properties on PEI: Upton Farm, where forage research is located; and Harrington Farm, which accommodates about 70 percent of the center's field studies in cereals, potatoes, and soil tillage and conservation. The three locations have a total land base of 383 hectares.

The center also operates the Nappan Research Farm in Nova Scotia. Beef research is conducted at Nappan where researchers are developing technologies for sustainable food production from beef cattle, integrating land and soil management, forages and animal resources. The Nappan Farm operates with a total budget of \$0.76 million and has approximately \$0.25 million in MII projects.

ASBESTOS ABATEMENT AND REMOVAL

Asbestos is a commercial name referring to a family of minerals which occur naturally in the environment. All asbestos minerals are composed of fibres. Since the early 1900s, asbestos was mined and used in industry and construction because of its valuable strength, durability and fire retarding properties. In the 1970s, airborne asbestos fibres were targeted as a health risk and consequently, asbestos use was markedly scaled back. In recent decades, efforts have been made to establish safe asbestos removal guidelines. Prince Edward Island's Occupational Health and Safety Act (Part 49) provides regulations for dealing with PEI's asbestos remediation. The regulations demand that all asbestos be double bagged. All contractors must be licensed to remove asbestos and disposal permits are issued by provincial environment officials.

PETROLEUM TECHNOLOGIES AND SERVICES

Prince Edward Island's reliance on groundwater means any spill of petroleum product is a potentially serious event. In 1999, there were 372 recorded spills of petroleum product in the province – 208 of these were from domestic home heat tanks. The remaining 44 percent originated from other sources including accidents and underground leaks. In the early 1990s, Prince Edward Island initiated a very successful program for the location and removal of abandoned underground fuel storage tanks. 2,200 of these were subsequently removed for proper disposal. Due to this activity, we have a number of experienced and qualified companies in the province. Contractors are licensed by the province for this remediation work. They are certified at either Level One (which permits them only to remove a tank) or Level Two (which permits them to both remove and install tanks).

SEPTIC SERVICES

Almost half of all residents in Prince Edward Island use on site sewage disposal systems to discard wastewater from their homes. Approximately 45 percent of all water used by the typical Island family is flushed from their homes. Therefore, it is recommended that these septic systems be cleaned regularly, usually every three to five years. All septic tank cleaners must be licensed by the Province and abide by legislation as outlined in the provincial Environmental Protection Act. Septic service providers in Prince Edward Island may be installers, cleaners or both. Contact individual companies to determine which service they provide.

WELL DRILLERS

Prince Edward Island is unique in Canada in that it is the only province which relies solely upon groundwater for its water supply. Groundwater soaks into the tiny spaces and cracks in the soil and bedrock as it would in an immense sponge. This saturated soil and bedrock sponge is called an aquifer. Wells can be drilled down into these aquifers almost anywhere in Prince Edward Island. Almost 40 percent of Islanders have their water supplied by on-site private wells. The average Island household uses between 1,140 and 1,820 litres of water daily. This makes Prince Edward Islanders among the greatest consumers of water in all of Canada. Well driller specialists must be licensed with the Province. Regulations also exist regarding well construction, abandonment and the sharing of groundwater.
