Avoid waits. Choose your campsite directly on the Internet. Check availability and location, click on the site of your choice and reserve on line.

## ● MAIN RESERVATION TERMS & CONDITIONS

As of January 15, you will be able to choose your campsite up to 4 months in advance throughout the Parcs Québec network. To be fair to all campers, **from now on the entry fee will be charged in addition to the camping fee in national parks.** The cost of a campsite in a national park has therefore been reduced. It is now even more advantageous to buy an **Annual Parcs Québec Card** for a single park or for the entire network.

Reserve your campsite all year long in Quebec's tourist resorts and wildlife reserves.

Non-refundable reservation fee:

**\$5/campsite (taxes incl.)**

Deposit required upon reservation:

**100% of the cost of your stay**

Campsite reservations do not automatically give occupants priority for extending their stays beyond the number of nights paid for.

Up to 7 days before the beginning of your stay:

- Full refund (minus reservation fees). Certain conditions apply on holidays.
- Modifications are accepted at all times.
- Modification fees apply for all downward modifications.

### CANCELLATIONS & MODIFICATIONS

6 days or fewer before the beginning of your stay:

No modifications or refunds for any reason.
