Your Woodlot Licence Plan (WLP) submission of May 2, 2006, and as amended November 2, 2006, for Woodlot Licence W1639 for the years 2006 to 2016 has now been fully reviewed.

**Determination:**

I am satisfied that the plan has been prepared and submitted in accordance with Section 13 of the *Forest and Range Practices Act* (FRPA) and the regulations. Accordingly, as the statutory decision-maker authority under Section 16 of the FRPA, I hereby approve your WLP.

The Ministry of Forests and Range remains committed to a meaningful consultation process with First Nations who may assert traditional aboriginal interests in an area covered by this WLP. The particulars of this WLP have been communicated to the appropriate First Nations and their input has been encouraged. To date, I have not been advised of any site-specific aboriginal interests that may be infringed upon by the proposed development described in this WLP.

The term of this plan is July 23, 2007, to July 22, 2017. Further development taking place on Woodlot Licence W1639 must be done in accordance with the approved WLP. This letter forms an integral part of the WLP for Woodlot Licence W1639 and should be attached thereto.
