- 6. All people will be accommodated near their chaperone.
- 7. Only 10% of the membership from your region and county will be accepted.
- 8. If, for some reason, the 4-H member does not conduct himself/herself according to the rules of 4-H Weekend; parents will be asked to come and take the child or children home. 4-H members can also be barred from participation in future events.
- 9. Counties are encouraged to hold County meetings with all attending prior to the event to ensure all are aware of the appropriate behaviour at 4-H weekend.
