Please fill in the blanks, sign the Permit, and carry it with you when you cut your Christmas Tree. Cutting of a Christmas tree without this Permit could result in confiscation of the tree and charges under the *Forest and Range Practices Act*.

FREE USE PERMIT FOR A CHRISTMAS TREE

	, hereby agree to the following:
1.	The Christmas tree is for personal use and not for resale;
2.	Will ensure that the Christmas tree is cut ONLY from the following areas on Vacant Crown
	Land:
	 Cleared Hydro Line Right of Ways.
	 Cleared Gas Pipeline Right of Ways
	♦ Cleared Road Right of Ways
3.	Leave stumps no higher than thirty (30) centimetres (1 foot) from the ground;
4.	DO NOT cut any tree taller than 5 meters.
5.	DO NOT cut any trees within 30 meters of any stream, wetland, or lake.
6.	Clear any debris from roads, roadside ditches and streams.
7.	Assume responsibility for any damage, injury claim, or expense that the Crown faces as a result, directly or indirectly, of the activities carried out in connection with this permit.
8.	This Permit is subject to the Forest and Range Practices Act.
	Permit is not valid until it is signed by the Applicant and is valid for one (1) month from the of issuance.
