

Location:

587 km from Québec City and 835 km from Montréal

Reception:

Port-Cartier year round; Lac Arthur and Lac Walker

in season

Bodies of water:

Over 1.000 lakes (about 100 are accessible), 15 rivers, and many streams

Fish:

Speckled trout. Atlantic salmon, Arctic char, lake smelt. and whitefish

Animals and Birds:

Abundant and varied. Mainly moose. black bear, wolf, lynx, fox, hare, porcupine, beaver, mink, otter, and marten. Many species of birds can be found on the reserve. including the ruffed grouse, spruce grouse, and migratory birds such as the Canada goose that stop over in spring and fall.

Forest cover:

Conifers, birch, and trembling aspen

Fishing that's worth the trip!

Of the more than 200,000 speckled trout that could be harvested annually at Réserve faunique de Port-Cartier-Sept-Îles, only 15% are actually caught. Thanks to pristine habitats and a scarcity of competing fish species, most of the lakes contain only indigenous speckled trout.

The conditions for speckled trout fishing in this first-rate territory are excellent:

- Daily catch limit: 20
- Average weight of trout caught: 180 grams each (350 grams and over in several lakes)
- Average catch per day, per fisher: 8 and over (over 12 in many lakes)



Réserve faunique de Port-Cartier-Sept-Îles is a true natural heritage treasure of Québec. This intriguing wilderness area offers fishing that is simply outstanding. The abundance of fish allows for a daily catch limit of 20 speckled trout per fisher. The trout is indigenous and the pristine quality of its habitat ensures good reproduction of the species.

Over a hundred or so lakes and some fifteen rivers teeming with good-sized speckled trout and wriggling salmon (Rivière aux Rochers and Rivière MacDonald) await sport fishers who want to test their mettle against the whims of these feisty fish.

A land of rough and breathtaking terrain, Réserve faunique de Port-Cartier-Sept-Îles is a stirring destination sure to create lasting memories that you'll want to share.
