AIR TRAVEL: DEPARTURE TIMES FROM...

 Please arrive at the airport one hour before the scheduled departure time.
 Should an agent confirm a different departure time one week before your departure date, you must stick to the new time. The time of your return flight will be confirmed when you register at the Port-Menier
 Visitors Centre.

RUNNING LATE? LET US KNOW!

If you are going to be late for the plane, we would greatly appreciate your notifying one of our agents by phone.

NOT TRAVELING WITH US?

If you have reserved your flight other than through Sépaq Anticosti, it is essential that you notify us of when you will be arriving in Port-Menier. That way, we can be there to greet you at the airport.

IMPORTANT 2007...YOUR BAGGAGE: MAXIMUM 50 LBS

Due to a limited weight allowance on the plane and for flight safety, there is no guarantee that you will be able to bring extra luggage... Exceptionally, if the weight allowance has not been reached, some surplus luggage may be accepted for \$4.40/kg (\$2/lb) on your way to Anticosti and \$4.40/kg (\$2/lb) on your way home.

TO AVOID PAYING EXTRA FOR LUGGAGE, ORDER AHEAD AND SAVE TIME...

The Port-Menier (CCIA) grocery and butcher shop offers a wide variety of fruits, vegetables and cheeses, plus butcher, bakery and grocery services, a Société des Alcools (SAQ) agent and an excellent choice of products for the same prices as on the continent. You can borrow a cooler to store and transport your purchases (deposit required: approximately \$20). Order ahead of time so you can arrive at your place of accommodations more quickly.

GETTING TO ANTICOSTI

AT THE AIRPORT...

When you arrive at the Port-Menier Airport, a member of our team will be there to greet you. If your package includes a vehicle, please read the insurance clause on your invoice. As with a vehicle rental, you are responsible for the vehicle assigned to you. To speed up the process at the rental counter, make sure you have all the necessary documents on hand: driver's license, copy of insurance (where applicable), etc. Then go directly to the Sépaq Anticosti office in the Village of Port-Menier. Follow the signs—it's only about a five-minute drive.

AT THE VISITORS CENTRE

All visitors must check in at our Visitors Centre in Port-Menier and receive safety information before traveling in the Sépaq Anticosti territory. You must also complete a registration card for each member of your party. The office staff will let you know of any particular road conditions on Anticosti and will explain how to use the radiocommunication device. And if you plan to enjoy a little fishing while you're here, you can also purchase a fishing license. Ask about all the options available!

NORTH-SOUTH OPTION... MIGRATE AND DISCOVER EVEN MORE!

Due to the sheer size of Anticosti and at the request of our customers, we have created the North-South option, which consists of three days on the north side and four days on the south side of the island, or vice versa, so you can visit each area and discover the many fascinating facets of the island.

Be sure to leave your first accommodations location by 10 AM and move into your second by 3 PM.

LAKE FISHING IN JUNE... FOR MEMORABLE FISHING TALES

While we can't guarantee miracles, the fishing will be good... and the spellbinding surroundings even better! You will fish in a sector that is reserved exclusively for your group. Fishing access rights are included for a number of lakes, and life jackets, a row boat and motor will be provided. Here are our suggestions for fishing gear:

You'll enjoy Rivière La Loutre, the perfect place to try your hand at fly fishing. You can also fish for trout at Petit and Grand Lac Long lakes. We urge you to carefully read the section on your invoice about catch limits on Anticosti Island.

Most popular flies: Rusty Rat, Silver Rat, Silver Cossaboom, Pattern Fly, Black Ghost, Mickey Finn, Bomber and Green Machine.

ACTIVITIES... FOR THE YOUNG AND YOUNG-AT-HEART

Anticosti Island boasts a wide range of activities you can enjoy alone, as a couple, or with the whole family. You will receive a copy of the Park Journal when you arrive in Port-Menier. Be sure to consult it for the complete activity program. The following is a brief summary of what's available. For information and to sign up, go to one of the two Visitors Centres —McDonald on the north side or Chicotte-la-Mer on the south side.

ACTIVITIES AND RATES

Please take note that activities are held if the weather and number of participants are favorable.

SEA KAYAKING Various departure times and excursion lengths from dawn to dusk............\$45 to \$100 Available through Expédition Agaguk

HORSEBACK RIDING Choice of guided excursions\$25/hour/adult (minimum age : 14)

HIKING Self-guided hikes......Free

A network of hiking trails takes you straight to the park's and Anticosti's most beautiful attractions.

To help you fully appreciate all natural wealth, be sure to pick up a copy of Ecoguide, a collection of wildlife,

DAY FISHING On lakes or rivers........starting at \$15/person/day

Reserve by radio communication 24 hours in advance at the McDonald or Chicotte-la-Mer Visitors Centres. A popular complementary activity that may be affected by weather conditions, so it is best not to make it the

focal point of your stay.

Treat yourself...

To add a gourmet touch to your stay, be sure to dine at one of the inns at McDonald, Chicotte-la-Mer, or Auberge Port-Menier, where you will enjoy mouth-watering full-course meals or à la carte items featuring regional specialties. Simply reserve your table by radio communication a few hours in advance. When you arrive on the island, ask about the business hours of these restaurants.

Did you know...

Lobster season on Anticosti is from June to July.

GAS

The two gas stations on the terrain are located at the McDonald and Chicotte-la-Mer Visitors Centres. Make sure to fill up your tank on your way by!

THE ROAD TO YOUR HOME-AWAY-FROM-HOME

On the day of your arrival, it is best to start off for your place of accommodations without too much delay... Take advantage of the light to travel. The distances are sometimes long. Be careful on the roads. Wood transport may be taking place in some sectors.

CHECKLIST ...WHAT TO BRING TO ANTICOSTI

Anticosti is characterized by a sub-boreal climate, which means that it gets quite hot on sunny days but nights are cool, so you'll sleep well. Temperatures tend to range between 10°C and 25°C. For your comfort, be sure to pack some warm clothes.

Anticosti Island is the perfect place for picnics, more elaborate dinners, or enjoying a snack around the fireplace. Keep that in mind when you go grocery shopping!

PARC NATIONAL D'ANTICOSTI... THE ENCHANTMENT OF A MYSTERIOUS ISLAND




With its creation in 2001 by the Québec Government, Parc national d'Anticosti (572 km²) became the biggest land park to be created in Québec since 1981. The park includes examples of all the natural features found on Anticosti Island, including some that are unique in Québec and Canada. A jewel in Québec's natural heritage, the park boasts breathtaking scenery, easily observed wildlife, and fascinating flora, and offers visitors a world of beauty and enchantment.
