Non-migrant movers - lived at a ditterent address but in the same census subdivision (CSD).
Average - or arithmetic mean is calculated by dividing the sum of included categories by the number of included categories
Median - an alternate measure of 'averageness'. Median income of a specific group is that amount which divides their income size distribution into two halves (below and above the median). Incidence of low income - the percentage of a specific group below Statistics Canada's low income cut-offs (LICO).
