

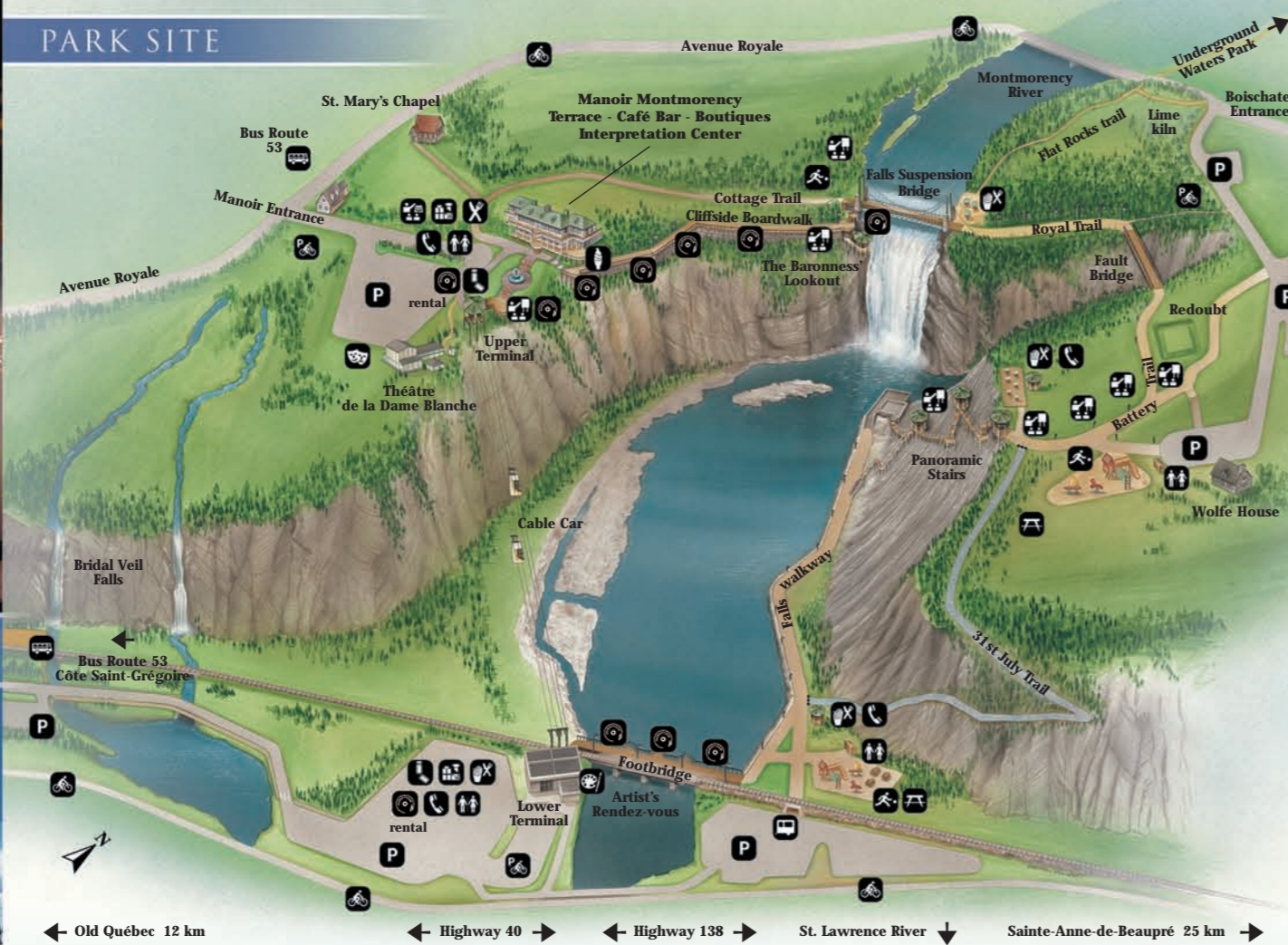


SPECTACULAR!

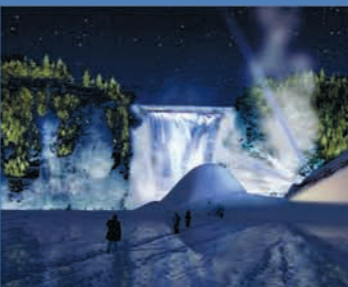

A few minutes from the Capital, Parc de la Chute-Montmorency enchanting domain is an invitation to relax and give your senses a treat. The awe-inspiring 83-meter-high waterfall (272 ft.) which is 30 meters higher (98.5 ft.) than Niagara Falls, is bordered by trails and lookouts offering an unforgettable panorama. The views are stunning from every vantage point whether you are taking **the cable car**, climbing the **panoramic stairs** or strolling across **suspension bridge**. Discover the mighty St. Lawrence stretching away to the horizon, the green oasis of Île d'Orléans, and the foaming rush of the falls themselves.

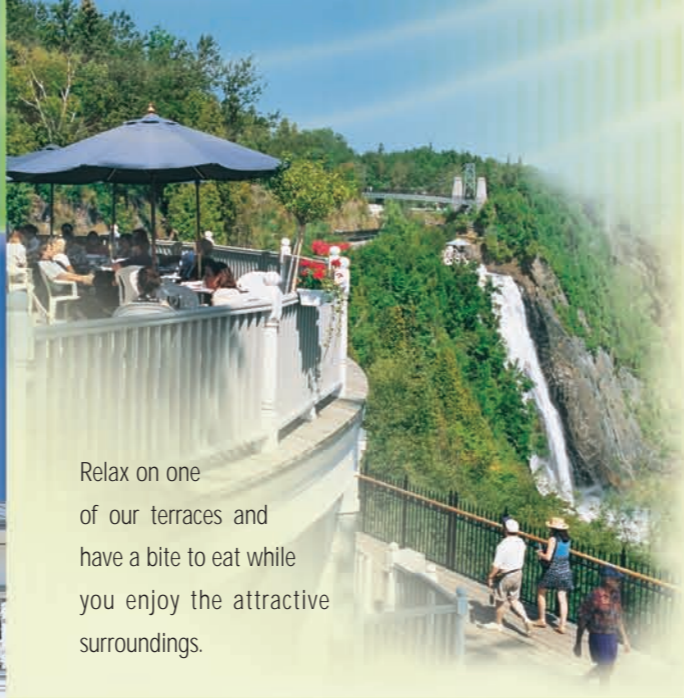


Perched a top of the rock basin wall carved out by the falls, stands the magnificent Manoir Montmorency. This elegant villa, which Houses an Interpretation Center, some souvenirs boutiques, a panoramic terrace and a café bar is a rendez-vous and a favourite with area residents.

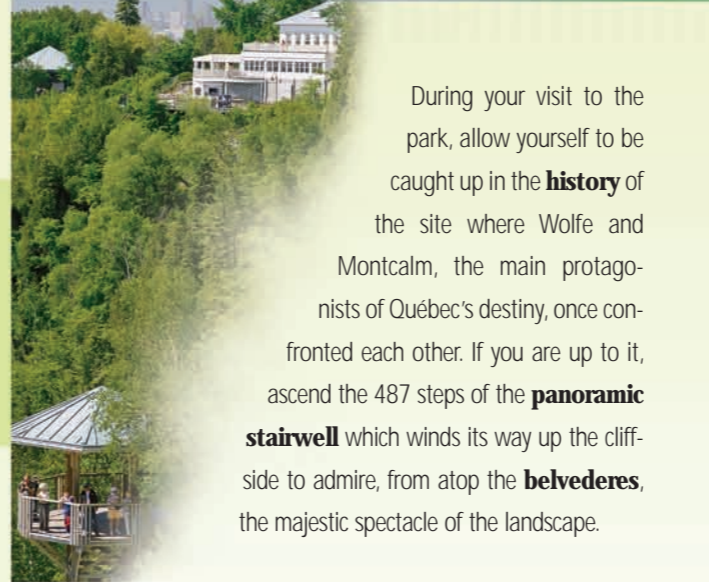
Relax on one of our terraces and have a bite to eat while you enjoy the attractive surroundings.

Nowhere else in the provincial capital is it as pleasant to enjoy the moment as on the **panoramic terrace** of Manoir Montmorency, which feature a stunning view of the falls and its surroundings.



SUMMER AND...



During your visit to the park, allow yourself to be caught up in the **history** of the site where Wolfe and Montcalm, the main protagonists of Québec's destiny, once confronted each other. If you are up to it, ascend the 487 steps of the **panoramic stairwell** which winds its way up the cliffside to admire, from atop the **belvederes**, the majestic spectacle of the landscape.

And if you learn more about the human and natural history of the site, visit the **Interpretation Centre** in the Manoir or take the **Audiotour**.

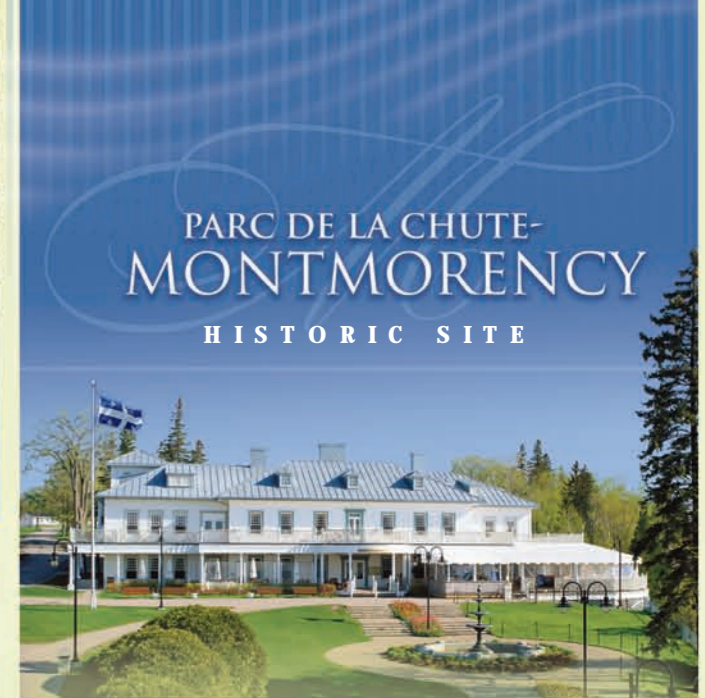


WINTER ALIKE



In winter, the park takes on a whole new look and special charm. Take a stroll up to the base of the falls to admire the **Sugarloaf**. Formed by frozen spray, this giant cone measures over 30 meters tall (100 ft.) and is the favourite spot for sledding.

Close by, the ice wall that encloses the falls during the cold months tests the skills of even the best climbers.
