Area:	1,628 km ²
Location:	82 km from Gatineau to the Val-des-Bois reception post and 190 km from Montréal to the Gagnon reception post
Reception:	The reserve has 15 unmanned entry points where information is posted. Access fees may be paid at the staffed Val-des-Bois, Pie IX, Gagnon, Mulet and La Minerve reception posts.
Bodies of Water:	762 lakes, 41 rivers and creeks
Fish:	Speckled trout, lake trout, smallmouth bass, walleye and northern pike
Animals and Birds:	White-tailed deer, moose, ruffed grouse, bears, wolves, beavers, foxes and many other mammal and bird species
Forest Cover:	Mixed forest dominated by stands of maple and yellow birch. Red oak, beech, linden, elm, ash, and conifers are also found in abundance.

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

Since 1998, with a view to ensuring the future of its resources and the sustainable management of its lands, Réserve faunique Papineau-Labelle has invested considerable time and money to acquire knowledge and carry out numerous wildlife management projects.



Aquatic management:

- 70 speckled trout spawning areas
- lake trout spawning area (Lac Ernest)
- tens of thousands of speckled trout eggs yearly implanted in spawning areas from 1999 to 2006

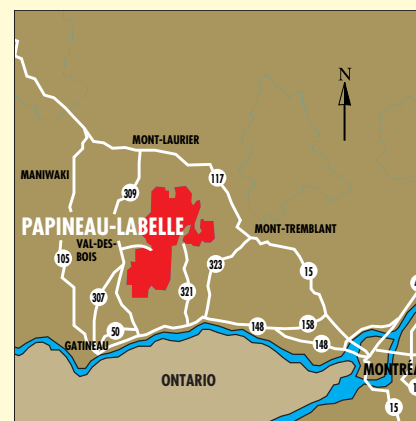
Land management:

- 5 managed alder groves for American woodcock reproduction
- 2 km of small game hunting trails
- 13 km of interpretation trails
- duck nesting boxes

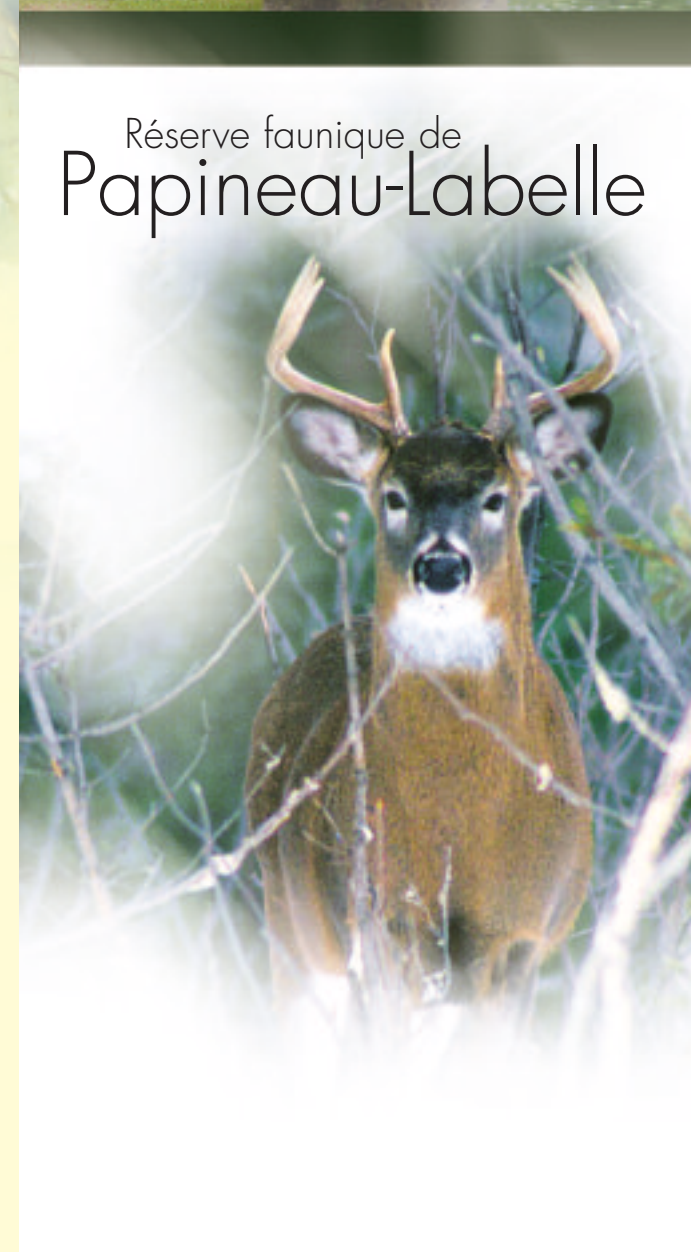

Réserve faunique Papineau-Labelle was created in 1971 to protect wildlife and provide all Quebecers with improved access to hunting, fishing, and outdoor recreational lands. The reserve, which boasts a rich and varied flora and fauna, was named after two famous Quebecers: Louis-Joseph Papineau, the great orator and politician renowned for his role in the uprising of 1837; and Antoine Labelle, the Saint-Jérôme priest nicknamed the *King of the North* for his key role in developing this region of Québec.
