reserve territory. Cross country skiing, ice fishing and snowshoeing complete the range of winter activities offered to a holiday clientele and snowmobilers staying overnight or longer. Many services are available to snowmobilers, including a restaurant and a retail fuel outlet. There are also three shelters located along the trail.

# Two Rivers, FourSeasons

Nestled between the Lanaudière and Laurentides regions, Réserve faunique Rouge-Matawin offers two very different settings, thanks to the presence of two distinct river systems sustaining the reserve, adjacent to parc national du Mont-Tremblant.

To the west flows Rivière Rouge, swift-paced in some places and leisurely in others. This river and its affluents are home to speckled trout, while to the east, northern pike abound in the winding, mysterious waters of Rivière Matawin and its tributaries.

In winter, complementary activities, an extensive trail network, comfortable accommodations, a restaurant and a service station make the region an attractive venue for snowmobile enthusiasts.
