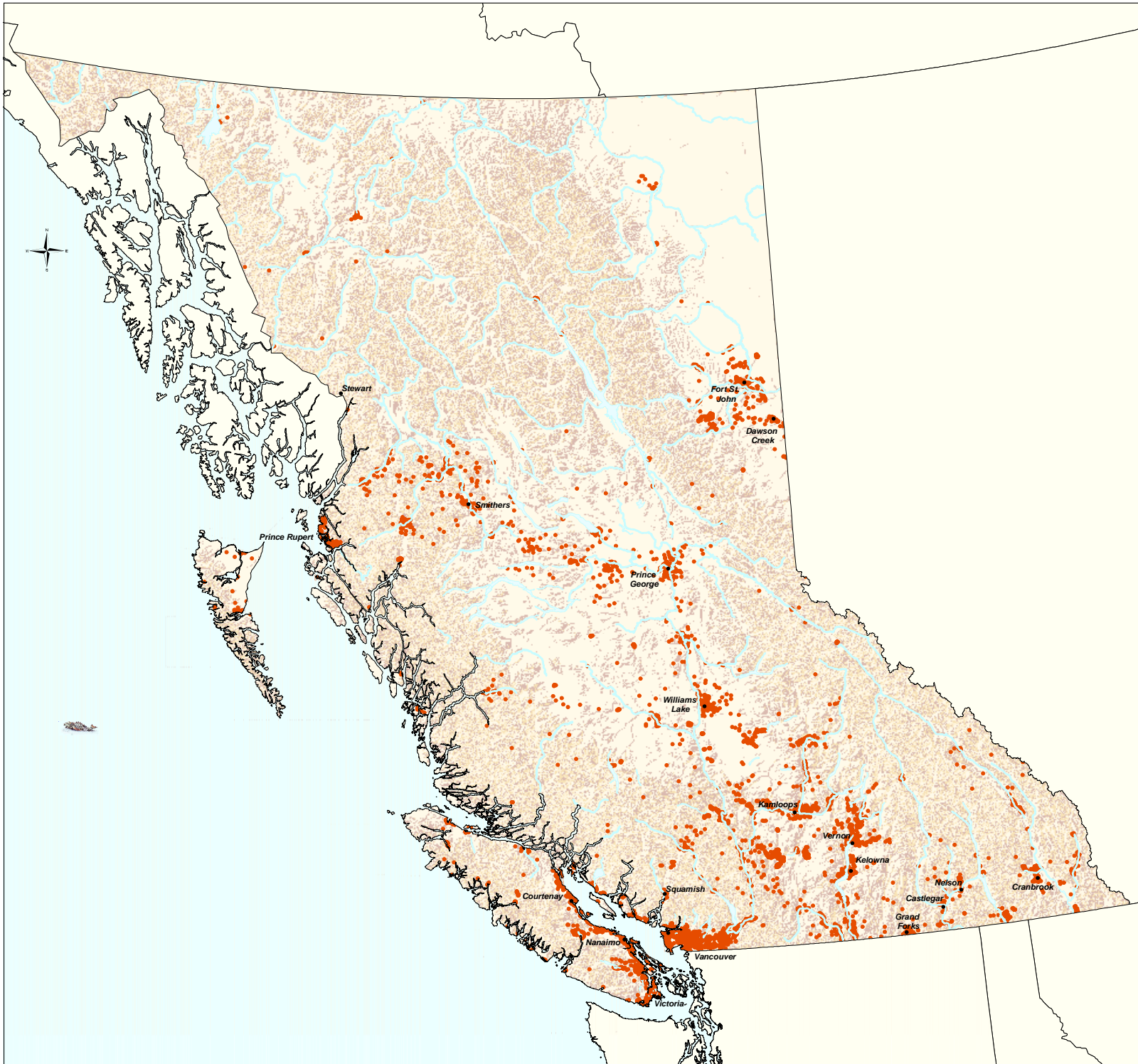

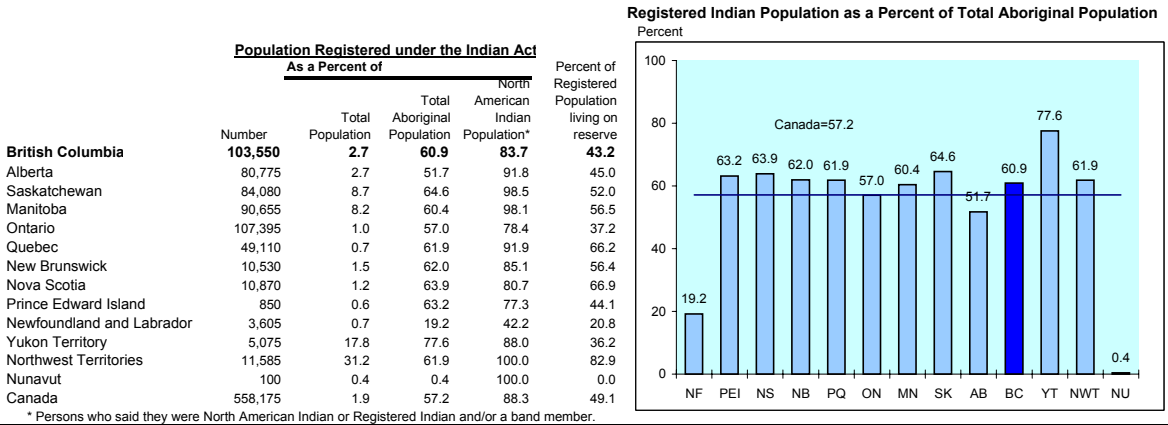

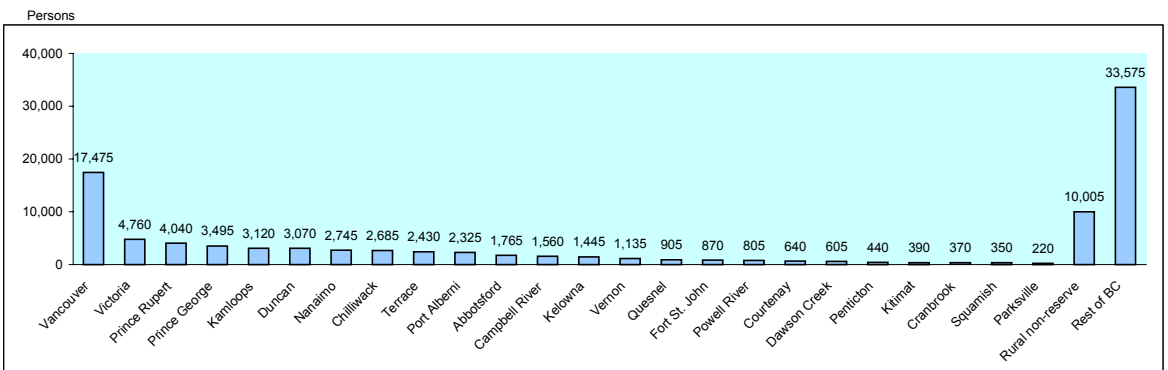

WHAT IS THE STATUS INDIAN REPRESENTATION IN BC COMPARED WITH THE REST OF CANADA?

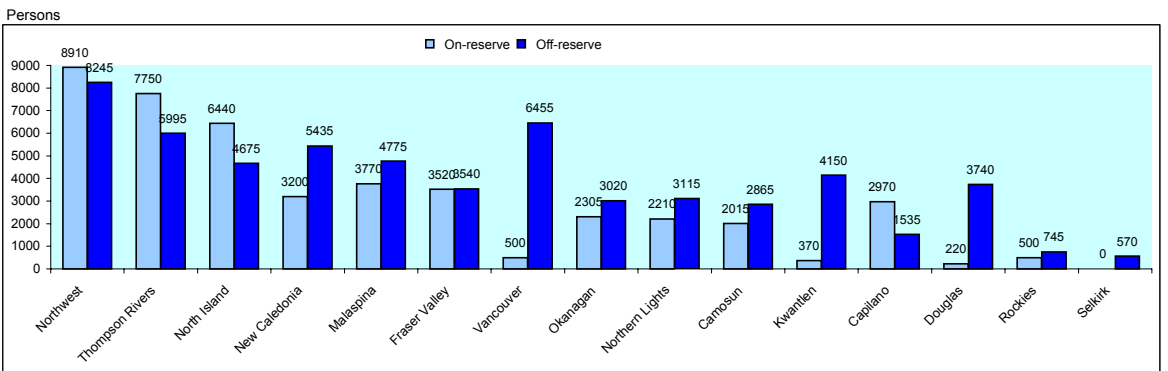


WHERE DOES THE BC'S STATUS POPULATION LIVE?

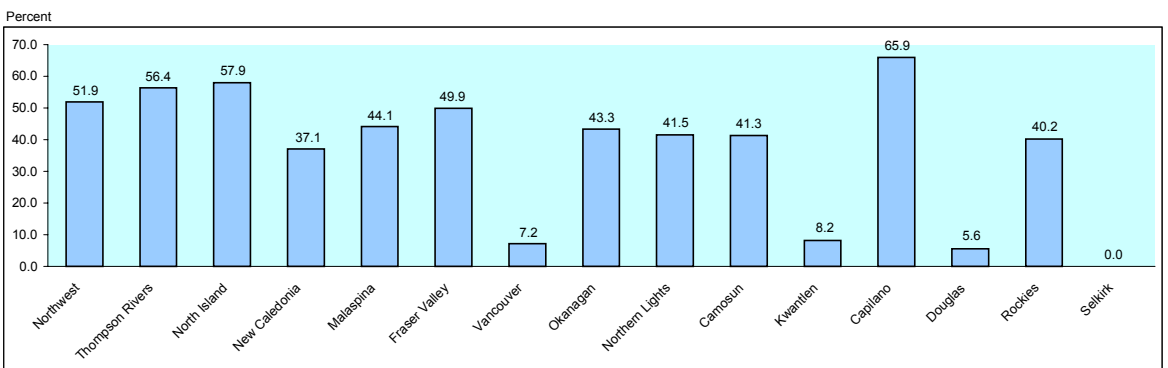
Number of Status Persons (Registered under the Indian Act) in Major urban Centres

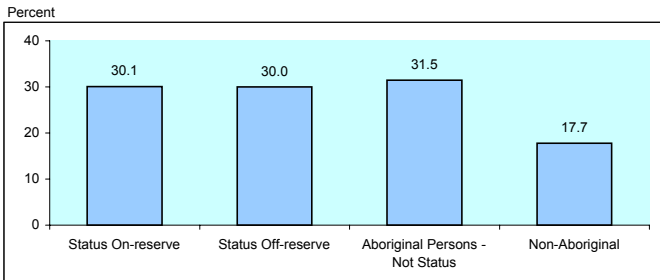

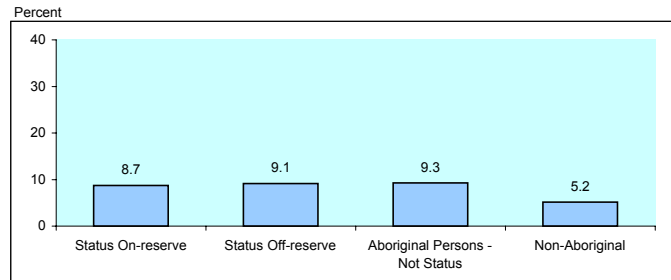

As a Percent of Total Population**

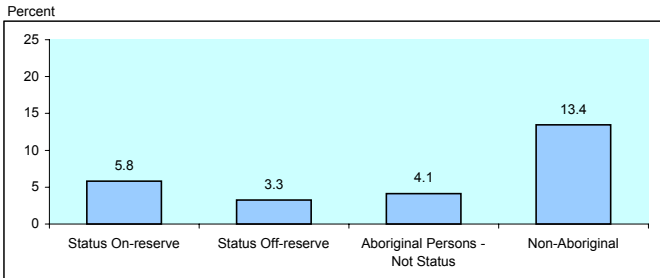


**Young Children 0-4 Years
As a Percent of Total Population**

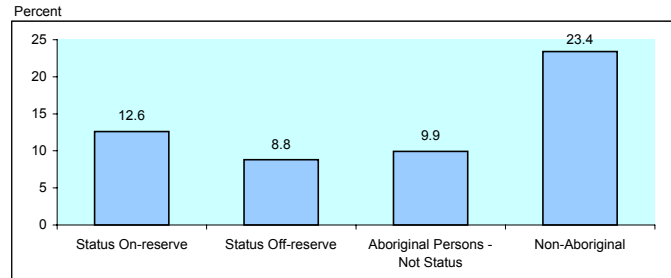


RELATIVELY FEW SENIORS?

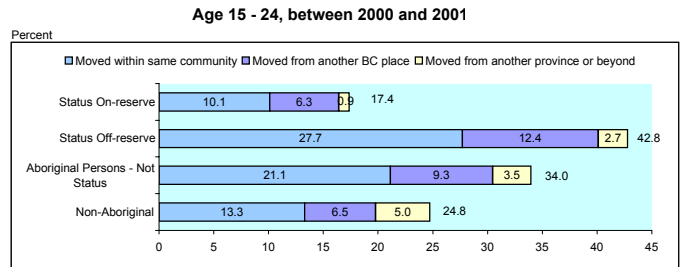
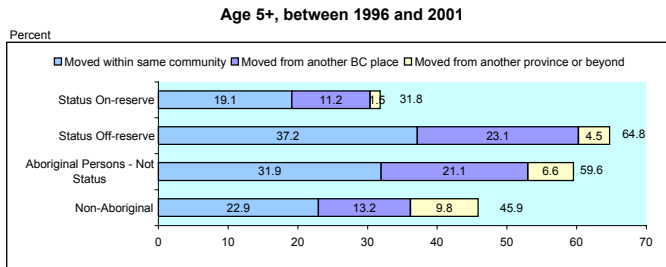

Percent of Population Who Moved



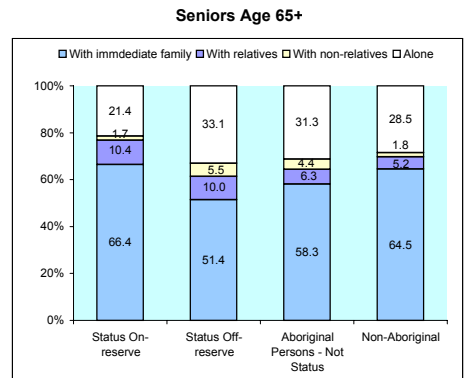
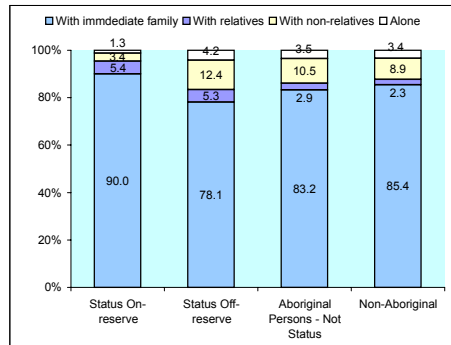
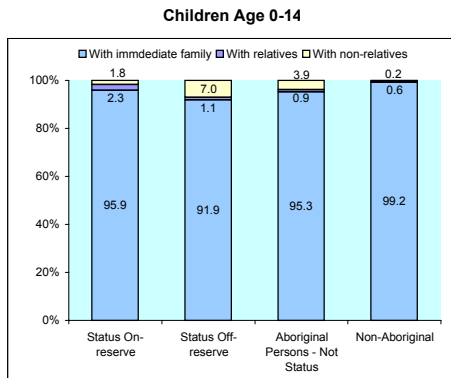

% of Population Age 25-64 with High School Graduation plus Post Secondary Completion

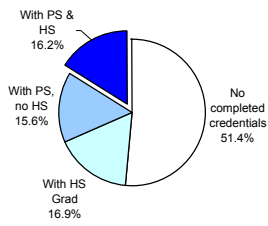

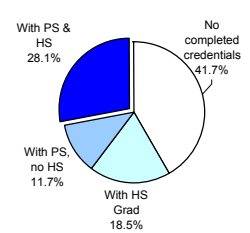


Status Indians Off-reserve Age 25-64

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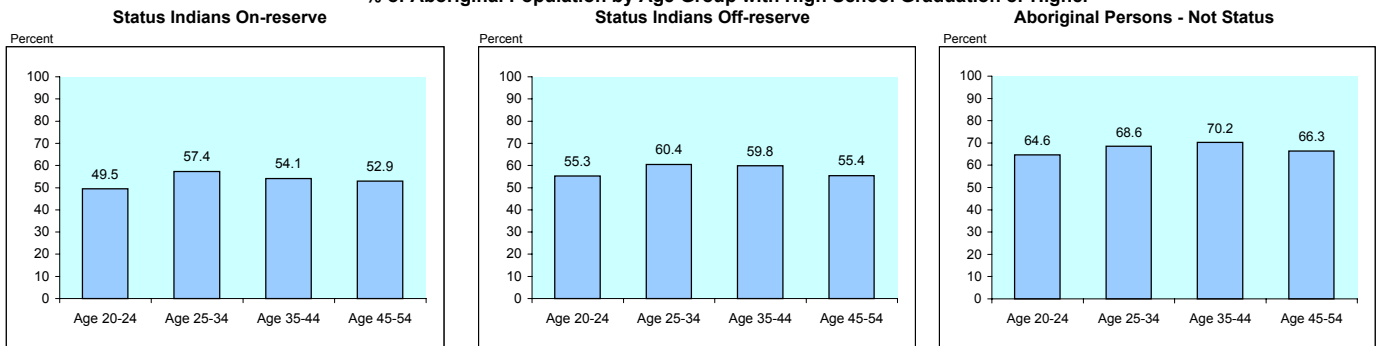

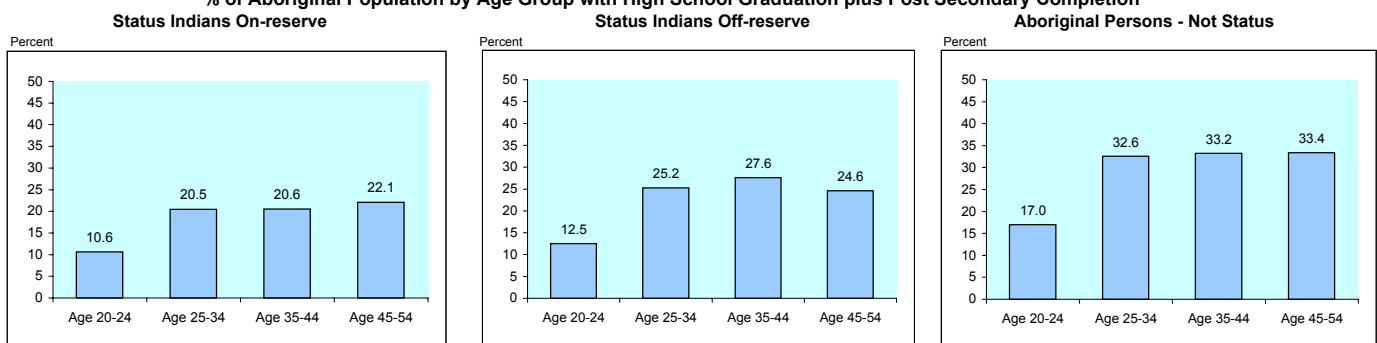

% of Aboriginal Population by Age Group with High School Graduation plus Post Secondary Completion



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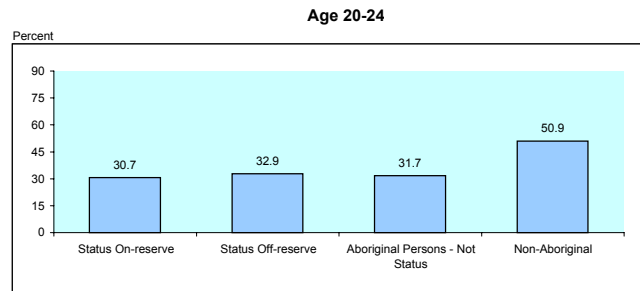
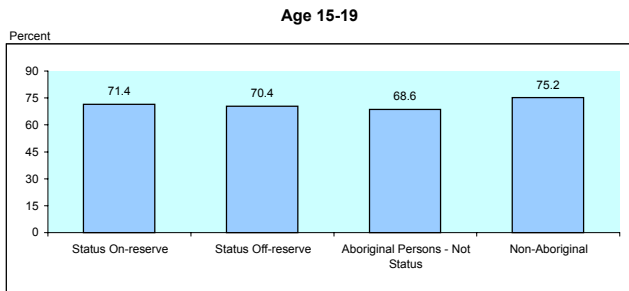
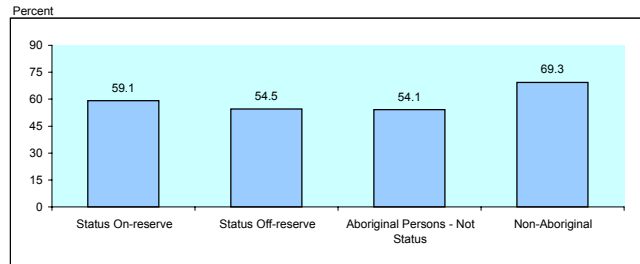
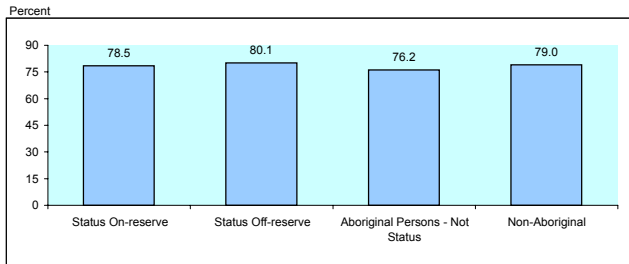

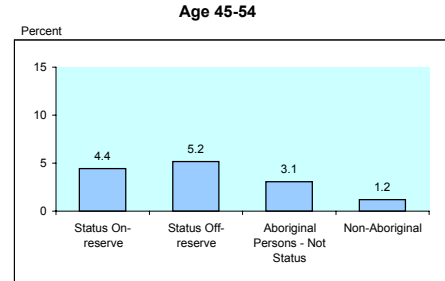
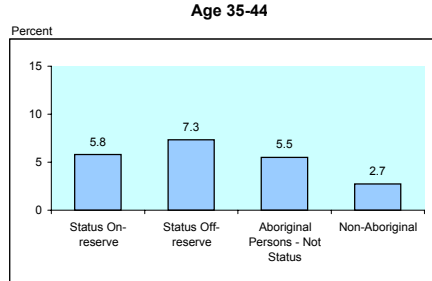
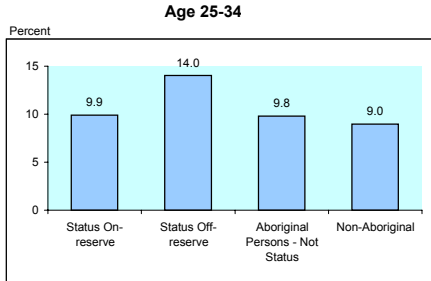
% of Population Who Attended School between September 2000 and May 2001

% of Population Who Attended School Full-time between September 2000 and May 2001



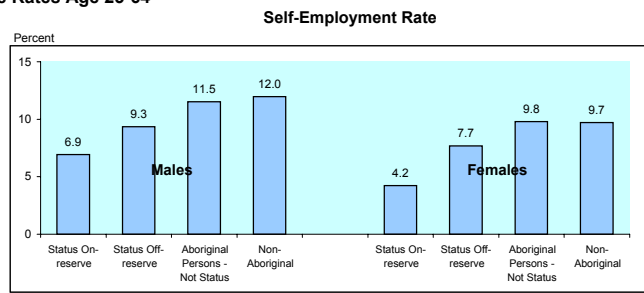
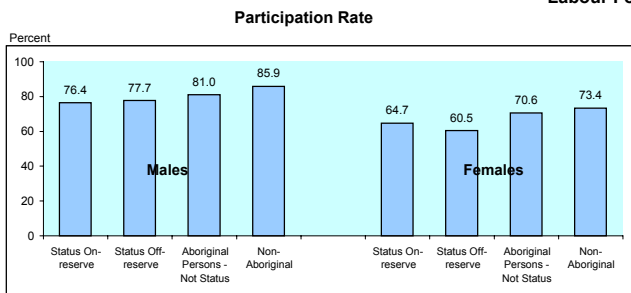

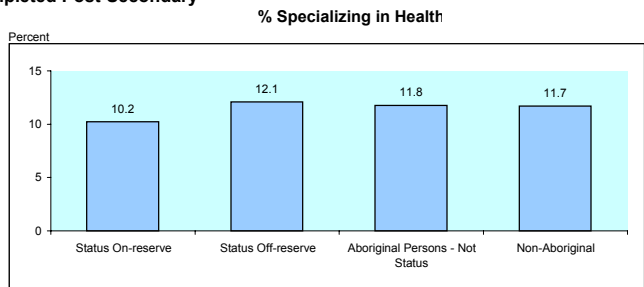
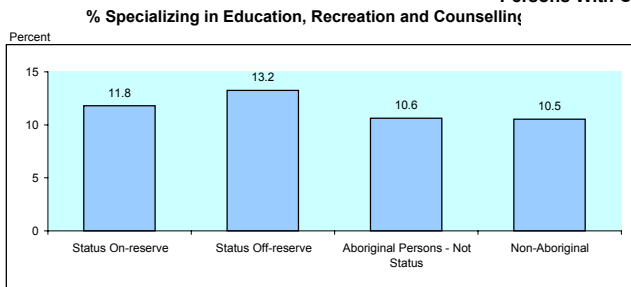
Labour Force Rates Age 25-64

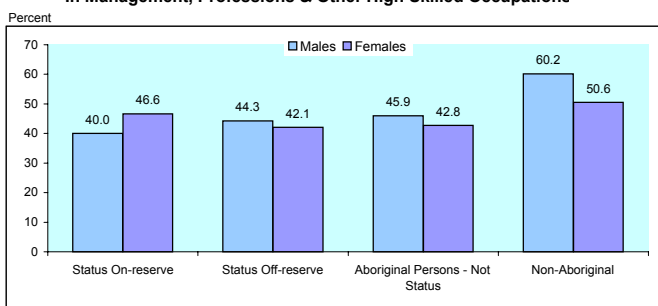

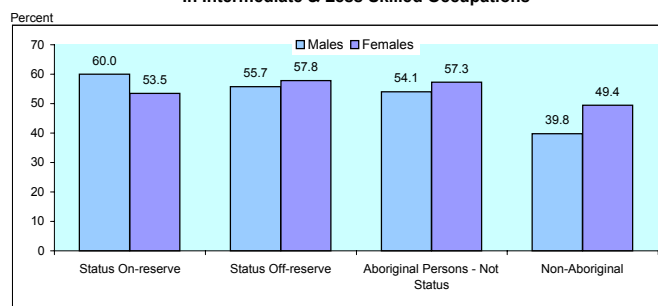

In Intermediate & Less Skilled Occupations

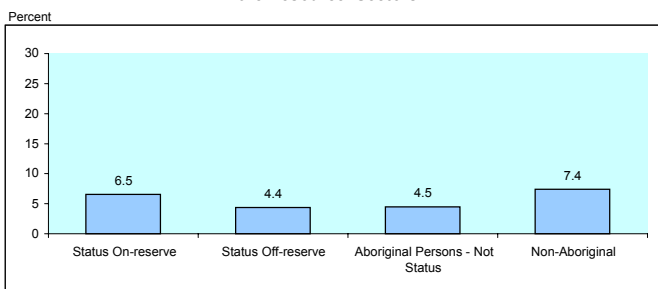

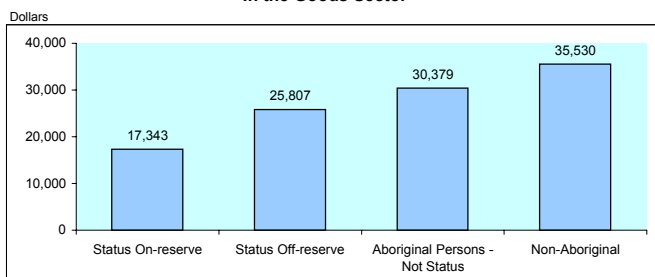

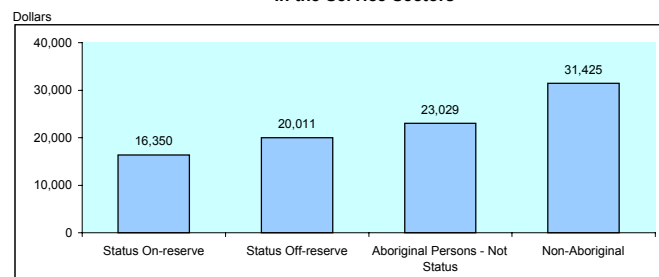

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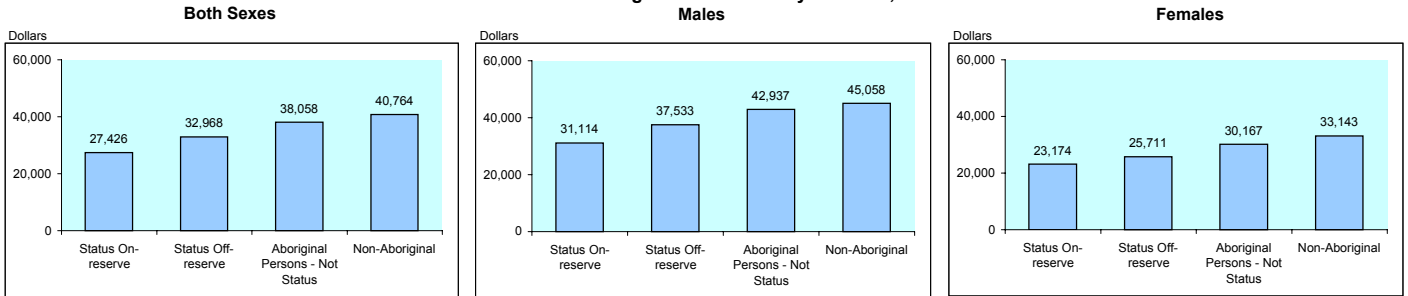

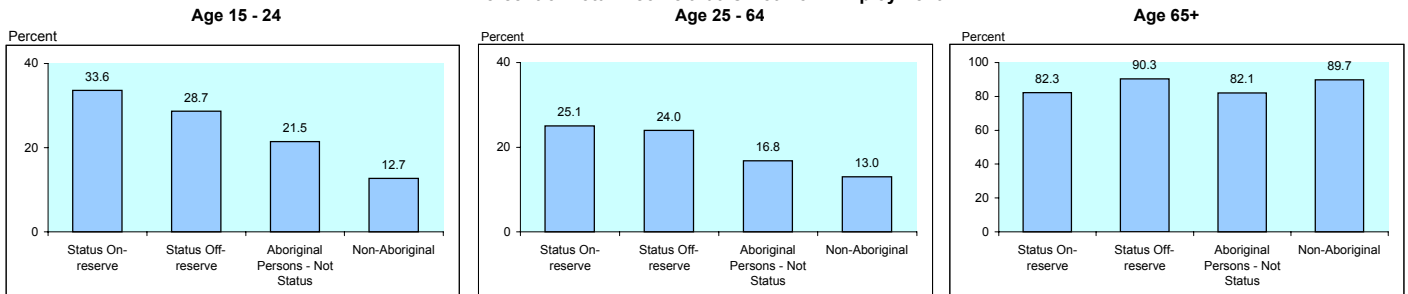
