The 2001 Economic Dependency Tables for Forest Districts

This set of tables was produced for the Ministry of Forests as a supplement to *British Columbia's Heartland at the Dawn of the 21st Century – 2001 Economic Dependencies and Impact Ratios for 63 Local Areas*. The same database and methodology have been utilized except that the results are for Forest Districts rather than the local areas defined in the main report.

The correspondence between these tables and those of the main report is clarified below.

The 2001 Economic Dependency Tables for Forest Districts

Table 1	Basic Sector Employment Estimates: employment estimates by sector and, for each basic sector, the percentage of total basic employment.
Table 2	Before Tax Income Estimates: before tax income estimates by sector and, for each basic sector, the percentage of total before tax income.
Table 3	After Tax Income Estimates: after tax income estimates by sector and, for each basic sector, the percentage of total after tax income.
Table 4	Employment Ratios – No Migration (with Safety Net): the potential impact (direct, indirect and induced) on the local economy of the gain or loss of one job in a basic sector. In the No Migration Scenario it is assumed that displaced workers receive employment insurance benefits and that new jobs are filled by previously unemployed residents. This table is analogous to Table 3.2 in the main report.
Table 5	Employment Ratios – Migration (no Safety Net): it is assumed that displaced workers leave the local area and that new jobs are filled by in-migrants. This table is analogous to Table 3.2 in the main report.
Table 6	Indirect Employment Ratios. Correspond to Table 3.1 in the main report.
