


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1996 Census Fast Facts

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Focus on BC Visible Minorities: Where They Live




- Of the 660,545 persons in BC who identify as visible minorities, 564,600, or 85.5 per cent, live in the Greater Vancouver Regional District (GVRD) and constitute 31.3 per cent of the GVRD population.
- Ninety-three per cent of visible minorities with a Chinese ethnicity live in the GVRD.
- Among the ethnic groups that make up the visible minority population in the GVRD, 70 per cent are from only two ethnic groups, Chinese, at 49.4 per cent, and South Asian, at 21.3 per cent.
- Although a significant proportion of the visible minority population in B.C. live in

the GVRD, other regional districts also possess a diverse ethnic mix.

- Over one quarter of all visible minorities in Skeena-Queen Charlotte are Filipino.
- In Central Kootenay 19 per cent of the visible minority population is black.
- In most Regional Districts in the province the highest proportion of visible minority population is either South Asian or Chi-

nese. The two exceptions are Central Kootenay and Fort Nelson-Liard where the highest per cent is Japanese. Central Kootenay's high proportion of Japanese population is partially due to temporary residents attending private education institutions in the Nelson area.
