Do you enjoy working with people? Do you value and nurture relationships with members of your community? Become a Constable and take full advantage of a wide range of opportunities that await you. As a provincial police service, the O.P.P. offers choices within your career path.

Become a Cadet...exploring a career in the OPP.

Cadets are responsible for providing a vast array of police support services. Every Cadet is provided with the opportunity to gain insights into the policing environment as well as to develop skills beneficial to pursuing a career as a police constable. Cadet positions are contract positions to be held up to a maximum of two years.

Basic Conditions of Appointment for Constable/Cadet

- Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- 18-65 years of age;
- Ontario Grade 12 or equivalency;
- Class ‘G’ driver’s licence with;
 - full driving privileges with no more than 6 demerit points;
- No criminal record for which a pardon has not been received or an absolute/conditional discharge that has not been sealed;
- Certified in First-Aid and C.P.R.; and
- Possess a valid Certificate of Results *(C.O.R.) *(Not required for the Cadet position).
