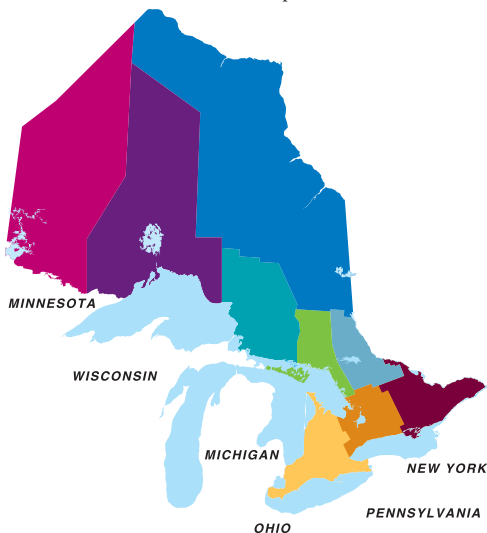

Each winter, thousands of snowmobilers choose to ride in Ontario for very good reasons: hospitality services and amenities that cater specially to snowmobilers; breathtaking scenery; unrivalled outdoor adventure; snowmobile-friendly communities; a wide variety of riding experiences and terrain; easy access to rental sleds and guided tours; excellent highways and airports; exciting city life and rural charm – the list goes on and on...

But the main reason they choose Ontario over any other destination is the snowmobile trails operated by the Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs (OFSC). These uncongested trails deliver the best trail riding opportunities bar none, with a season length of up to 16 weeks.

So why would you go anywhere else to snowmobile? With 42,000 kilometres (26,098 miles) of groomed trails, there's almost nowhere in Ontario you can't go by sled. OFSC trails connect snowbelt communities and provide access to hundreds of resorts, hotels, motels, restaurants, gas stations, snowmobile dealers and clubhouses.

Wherever you travel, you'll be warmly welcomed and offered every assistance to ensure your snowmobiling pleasure. You can ride any of our snowmobiling regions, or tour from Quebec to Manitoba on our world class

Trans Ontario Provincial (TOP) Trails. It's your choice . . . so come see us this winter and discover the excitement of Snowmobile Paradise Ontario!

USING THIS TOUR PLANNER

Now that you have decided to make Ontario your destination this winter, how do you go about answering your questions and making your plans?

Ontario is a very big place, so how do you decide what part of this province to visit? How do you know where the snow is and what trails are groomed? How do you get here and where do you stay? What else do you need to know?

Ontario is very snowmobile-friendly – and we want to prove it from the start by making it as easy and simple as possible for you to snowmobile here. That's why we've partnered with the OFSC to develop this handy Tour Planner. It's a companion piece to the 2008 OFSC TOP Trail Guide, which shows an overview of our trails.

The Tour Planner is your primary tour-planning tool. It details everything you need to know about snowmobiling in Ontario. It was written for snowmobilers by snowmobilers, so you can rely on the information it contains.

Much of this material can also be found by clicking ontariotravel.net/goride, but this Tour Planner provides you with a hard copy reference to carry with you and use when

you do not have internet access. It's like the bible of Ontario Snowmobiling, putting all the answers right at your fingertips!

ABOUT THE OFSC

The Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs (OFSC) represents the 236 local snowmobile clubs who operate Ontario's snowmobile trails. As the world's largest snowmobile association, the OFSC is the coordinating body for organized snowmobiling in Ontario. Click on *ofsc.on.ca* to find out more.

ADDITIONAL PLANNING TOOLS

Trail Guides: For tour planning, you should use the 2008 OFSC TOP Trail Guide, Ontario's only province-wide snowmobile trail map. Using this Guide allows you to see the big picture and how trails connect various regions. But remember, because Ontario is so large and has so many snowmobile trails, the TOP Trail Guide only shows TOP Trails – less than half of the total number of trails available for you to ride.

When you have decided what area(s) you wish to tour, you should also obtain an OFSC district guide(s) for greater detail and to discover many additional trails (see OFSC district contact info, page 49). Our 2008 district guides have been redesigned this year to be more user friendly. Each guide cover uses the same template, which clearly identifies the name of the tourism area and

OFSC district number (inside back cover), and includes a small Ontario key map showing what part of the province that guide covers.

A district guide is the best tool to use while actually traveling on the snow. Not only do they include regional and local information and contacts, they also contain ads from snowmobile-friendly lodgings, restaurants and other services who support organized snowmobiling.

Tourism & Trail Web Site:

Another excellent source of tour planning information is the Snowmobile Paradise Ontario micro site at *ontariotravel.net/goride*. Snowmobilers developed the content of this site to make it very useful to touring riders; it also contains links to all tourism regions, OFSC districts and the OFSC. This site contains information on: trails, permits, conversions (Fahrenheit to Celsius, U.S. dollars to Cdn. dollars, gallons to litres and miles to kilometres). It also contains links to a tour planner mapping tool, current trail condition reports (winter only), and to weather reports.

Publications: Several tourism regions provide winter publications with detailed information about snowmobiling. These are indicated with an * beside their name on page 48. The official membership magazine of the OFSC, is mailed to every snowmobiler who buys a Full Season

Permit (1-year subscription starts the season following permit purchase).

ABOUT OFSC TRAILS

- Ontario has the world's largest inter-connected snowmobile trail system (42,000 km/26,098 mi).
- The trail system is composed of the OFSC Trans Ontario Provincial (TOP) Trails (19,000 km/11,500 mi) and regional and local trails (25,000 km/15,000 mi).
- TOP Trails link most snow-belt communities, border crossings, tourism regions and regional trail systems.
- OFSC local and regional trails feed into the TOP Trail system, providing local links to a host of other communities, services and amenities, events and attractions.
- Snowmobilers are expected to know the "Assumptions for OFSC Trail Use" (see page 38) before entering OFSC trails.

TRAIL PERMITS

- Permits are available in advance from most OFSC districts (page 49) and snowmobile clubs.
- Permits are available on site from most winter businesses, such as sled dealers, restaurants, and motels.
- Permits generate the revenues OFSC clubs need to operate snowmobile trails.
- By purchasing a permit, each rider contributes to the cost of providing snowmobile trails.

- To ensure that your permit money goes to the OFSC district whose trails you ride most, it is important to buy your permit from a club in that district.
- For the 2007/08 Season, Snowmobile Trail Permit Fees are:

FULL SEASON PERMIT –
\$180 CDN on or before Dec. 1/07; \$230 CDN after Dec. 1/07 (unlimited riding, anywhere in Ontario, all season).

SEVEN DAY PERMIT –
\$120 CDN (unlimited riding, anywhere in Ontario for 7 consecutive days).

THREE DAY PERMIT –
\$90 CDN (unlimited riding, anywhere in Ontario for 3 consecutive days).
(One-Day Permit discontinued)

- Ontario law requires that each sled being used for recreational snowmobiling on an OFSC trail display a valid permit.

GETTING TO ONTARIO

Friendly and Familiar:

American snowmobilers are very welcome in Ontario. Ontario has always been a great friend and trading partner to the U.S. In fact, getting to Ontario isn't much different than going to a neighbouring state. We're just as close and our major highways connect seamlessly to yours at numerous border crossings.

In Ontario, we speak your language (except we spell some words funny!), use many of the same products, have similar laws – and ride the same brands of snowmobiles as you do. Best of all, each American dollar buys you more in Ontario than it does at home. Most Americans who travel to Ontario say they are very comfortable visiting here and look forward to coming back. Just remember that we measure distance and speed in kilometres. (for conversion chart visit ontariotravel.net/goride).

Crossing the Border:

If you are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of the United States, you won't need a passport to enter Canada. However, you will need proof of citizenship such as a birth certificate, citizenship certificate, passport or landing card. To cross the U.S./Canada border as quickly and smoothly as possible, please have a valid passport

and proof of citizenship, preferably with a current photo, ready to present when asked.

As a visitor to Canada, you are allowed to temporarily import passenger and recreational vehicles for personal use. You should carry a copy of your vehicle, trailer and sled registration and proof of insurance. Be sure to check in with U.S. Customs before leaving the U.S. You must take the temporarily imported items back with you by the date you end your visit. **SNOWMOBILING
LEGALITIES**

QUICK SUMMARY –
*To snowmobile legally in
Ontario, you must have:*

- valid driver's license
- proof of snowmobile ownership,
- registration,
- insurance,
- helmet
- snowmobile trail permit

FOR ALL SNOWMOBILERS:

- Ontario law requires that each sled being used for recreational snowmobiling on an OFSC trail display a valid permit.
- While operating a snowmobile, the same rules of the road and penalties apply as for driving a car, including possible fines, loss of driver's license, criminal record and/or imprisonment.

- Ontario requires the mandatory use of approved safety helmets according to the Highway Traffic Act Regulations while operating or riding a snowmobile.
- The operator of a snowmobile must be at least 12 years old and hold an Ontario motorized snow vehicle operator's license. Those 16 and over can use a valid driver's license instead.
- The maximum legal speed limit on Ontario trails is 50 kilometres per hour (35mph).

FOR ONTARIO RESIDENTS:

- All Ontario residents must register their motorized snow vehicles (MSV) with the Ministry of Transportation, display the registration numbers and show proof of insurance.
- All Ontario residents must display a current validation of their MSV.

FOR NON-RESIDENTS:

- All non-residents must produce evidence of insurance and registration, or bill of sale and comply with Ontario's snowmobile regulations.
- U.S. residents who are not compelled to insure their snowmobile in their own state must have liability coverage while in Ontario

(minimum \$500,000). They may do so through their car insurance.



ASSUMPTIONS FOR OFSC TRAIL USE

As an off-road activity that occurs in an unpredictable natural environment, snowmobiling has inherent risks. Each individual operator and passenger must understand that you willingly enter and use OFSC snowmobile trails at your own risk. Every snowmobiler must read The Assumptions for OFSC Trail Use before entering OFSC trails. The Assumptions and hand signal information can be found at ofsc.on.ca

À PROPOS DE LA OFSC

La Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs (OFSC) représente les 236 clubs de motoneige locaux qui exploitent les sentiers de motoneige de l'Ontario. La OFSC, la plus importante association de motoneige du monde, est l'organisme de coordination de la motoneige organisée en Ontario. Pour plus de détails, cliquez sur ofsc.on.ca.

AUTRES OUTILS DE PLANIFICATION

Guides des sentiers : Pour planifier vos randonnées, vous devriez vous servir du Guide des sentiers provinciaux trans-ontariens 2008 de la OFSC, qui fournit la seule carte complète des sentiers de motoneige de l'Ontario. Grâce à ce guide, vous aurez une vue d'ensemble des sentiers et de la façon dont ils relient les régions entre elles. Toutefois, comme l'Ontario est extrêmement vaste et compte tant de sentiers de motoneige, le Guide, comme son nom l'indique, ne donne que les sentiers provinciaux trans-ontariens, soit moins de la moitié de tous les sentiers accessibles en motoneige.

Une fois que vous aurez choisi la ou les régions que vous souhaitez sillonner, vous devrez vous procurer le ou les guides des districts de la OFSC pour avoir davantage de renseignements et découvrir

une foule d'autres sentiers (voir information personne-ressource dans les districts de la OFSC (à la page 49). Cette année, nos guides des districts 2008 ont fait peau neuve pour être plus conviviaux. La couverture de chaque guide se fonde sur le même modèle, indique clairement le nom de la région touristique et le numéro du district de la OFSC (voir page la couverture arrière intérieure) et comprend une petite carte de l'Ontario montrant la région de la province dont traite le guide en question.

Un guide des districts est en fait indispensable quand on se déplace en motoneige, car il comprend non seulement des renseignements régionaux et locaux, mais aussi des annonces d'établissements d'hébergement et de restaurants heureux d'accueillir des motoneigistes, ainsi que d'autres services qui apportent leur concours à la motoneige organisée.

Un site Web sur le tourisme et les sentiers : Le micro site de l'Ontario « Paradis de la motoneige » à l'adresse faireuntourenontario.ca constitue également une excellente source de renseignements pour planifier des randonnées. Préparé par des motoneigistes, le contenu de ce site est très utile pour se préparer à un circuit en motoneige ; il comprend des

liens vers toutes les régions touristiques, les districts de la OFSC et la OFSC, ainsi que des renseignements sur les sentiers, les permis, les conversions (Fahrenheit en Celsius, dollars américains en dollars canadiens, gallons en litres et milles en kilomètres), des liens vers un outil de cartographie pour tracer l'itinéraire d'une randonnée, des rapports sur l'état de sentiers (en hiver seulement) et des bulletins météorologiques.

LES OBLIGATIONS JURIDIQUES DE LA CONDUITE EN MOTONEIGE

Renseignements sommaires – Pour conduire légalement une motoneige en Ontario, vous devez avoir :

- un permis de conduire valide,
- le titre de propriété de la motoneige,
- le certificat d'immatriculation,
- une assurance,
- un casque,
- un permis d'utilisation des sentiers en motoneige.

POUR TOUS LES MOTONEIGISTES :

- La loi ontarienne exige qu'un permis valide soit apposé sur toute motoneige utilisée à des fins récréatives sur les sentiers de la OFSC.
- Le code de la route et les sanctions possibles sont les mêmes que pour la conduite d'une automobile, y compris amendes, retrait du permis de conduire, casier judiciaire et/ou emprisonnement.
- Conformément aux règlements du Code de la route, l'Ontario exige que tout utilisateur d'une motoneige et son passager portent un casque de sécurité.
- L'utilisateur de motoneige doit avoir au moins 12 ans et être titulaire d'un permis d'utilisateur de motoneige.

Les utilisateurs d'au moins de 16 ans révolus peuvent détenir à la place un permis de conduire valide.

- La vitesse maximale autorisée sur les sentiers de l'Ontario est de 50 kilomètres à l'heure (35 mi à l'heure).

POUR LES RÉSIDENTS DE L'ONTARIO :

- Tous les résidents de l'Ontario sont tenus d'immatriculer leur motoneige auprès du ministère des Transports et de détenir une assurance. La motoneige doit porter à un endroit visible son numéro d'immatriculation.
- Tous les résidents de l'Ontario doivent afficher sur la motoneige l'attestation de la délivrance ou de la validation du permis.

POUR LES NON-RÉSIDENTS :

- Tous les non-résidents doivent fournir la preuve d'assurance et d'immatriculation, ou l'acte de vente et satisfaire aux règlements de l'Ontario sur l'utilisation d'une motoneige.
- Les résidents des États-Unis qui ne sont pas tenus d'assurer leur motoneige dans leur propre État doivent détenir une police de responsabilité automobile pendant leur séjour en Ontario (minimum 500 000 \$).

LES CONVENTIONS D'UTILISATION DES SENTIERS DE LA OFSC

En tant qu'activité tout-terrain dans un environnement naturel imprévisible, la conduite d'une motoneige comporte des risques inhérents. L'utilisateur et le passager doivent comprendre qu'en acceptant d'emprunter les sentiers de la OFSC ils le font à leur propre risque. Tout motoneigiste doit lire les Conventions d'utilisation des sentiers de la OFSC avant de les emprunter. On peut les consulter sur le site *ofsc.on.ca*

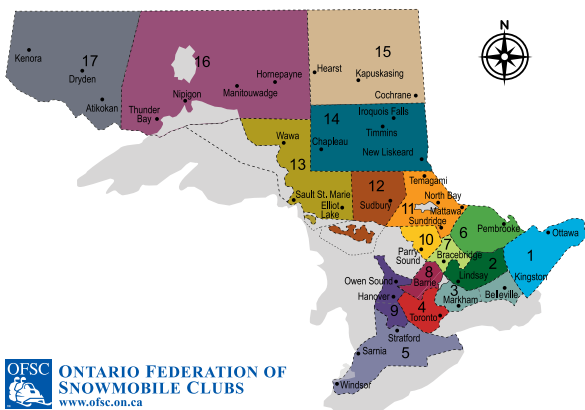
