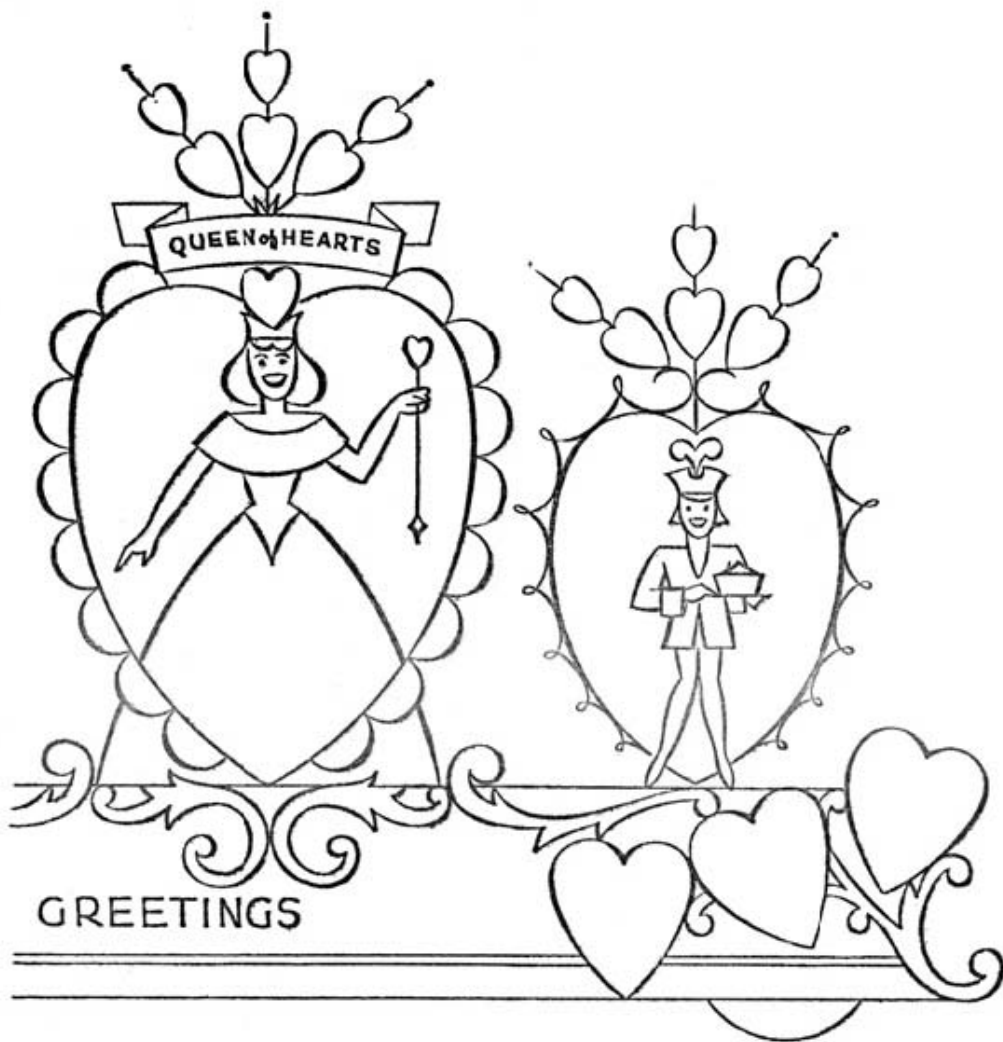
JANUARY



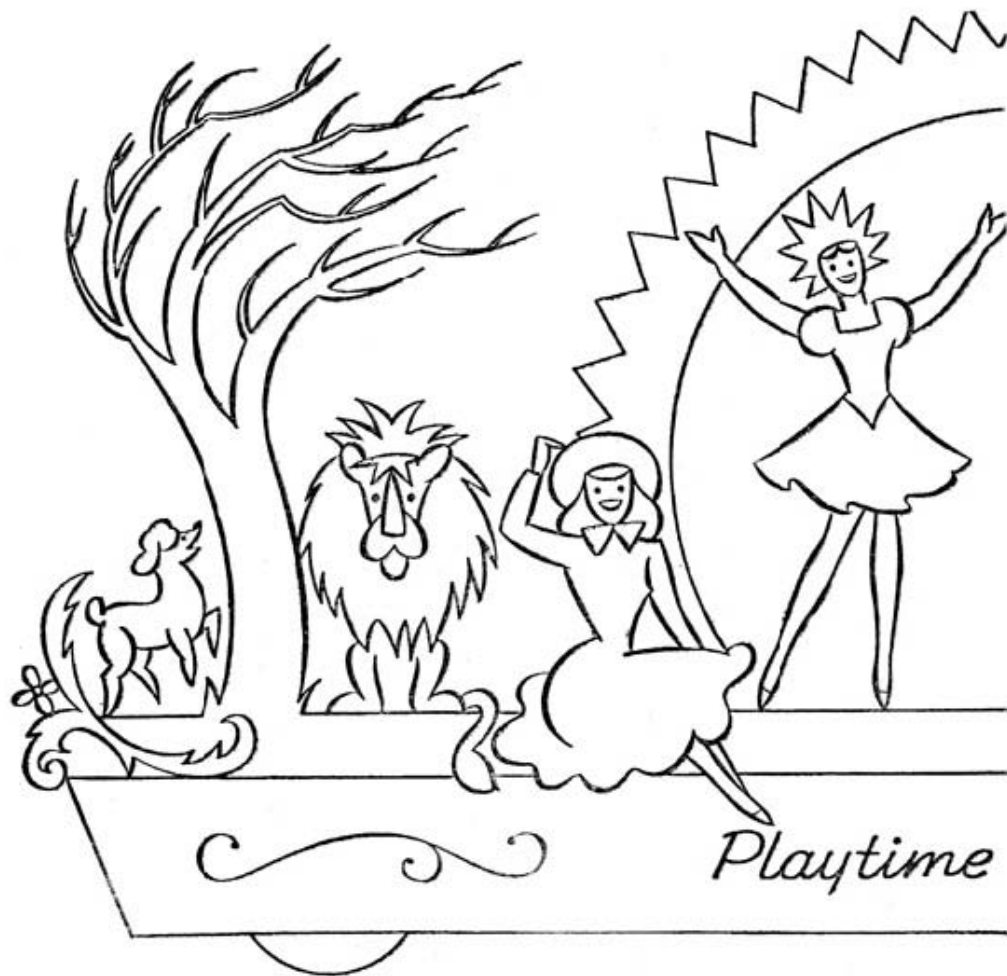
First, of course, comes January! And what fun we have then! Fun in a bright white fairyland of snow! We say, "Maybe this is the happiest month of all!"



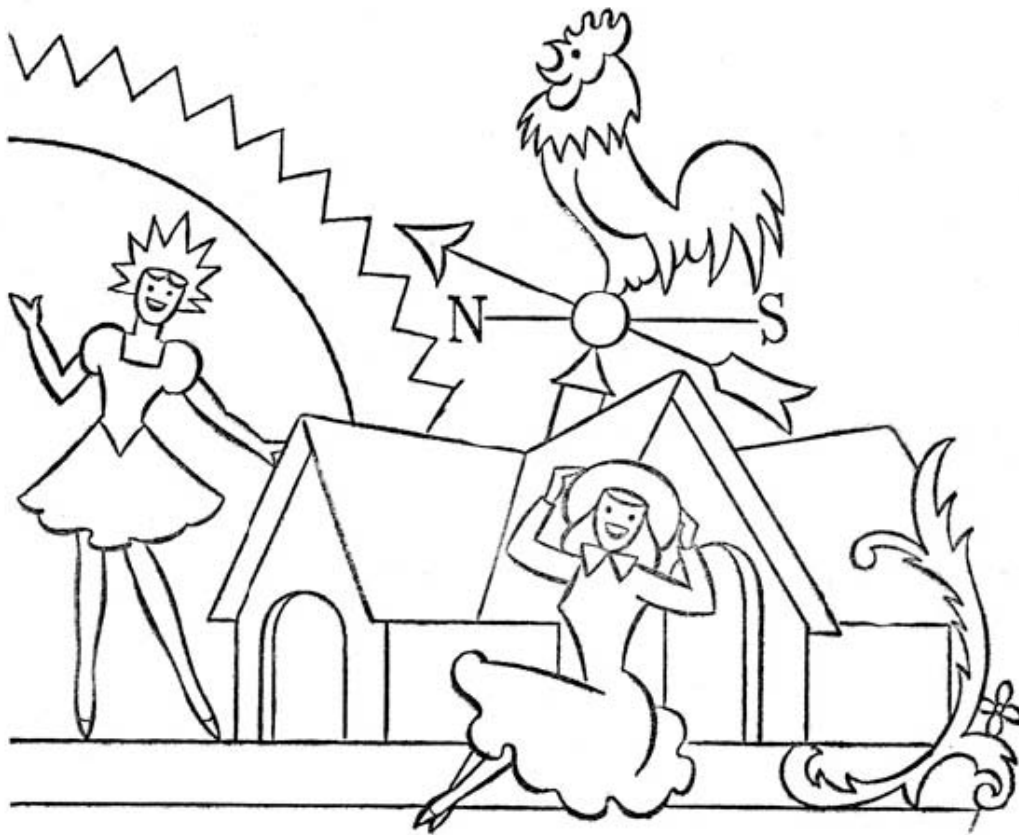
FEBRUARY

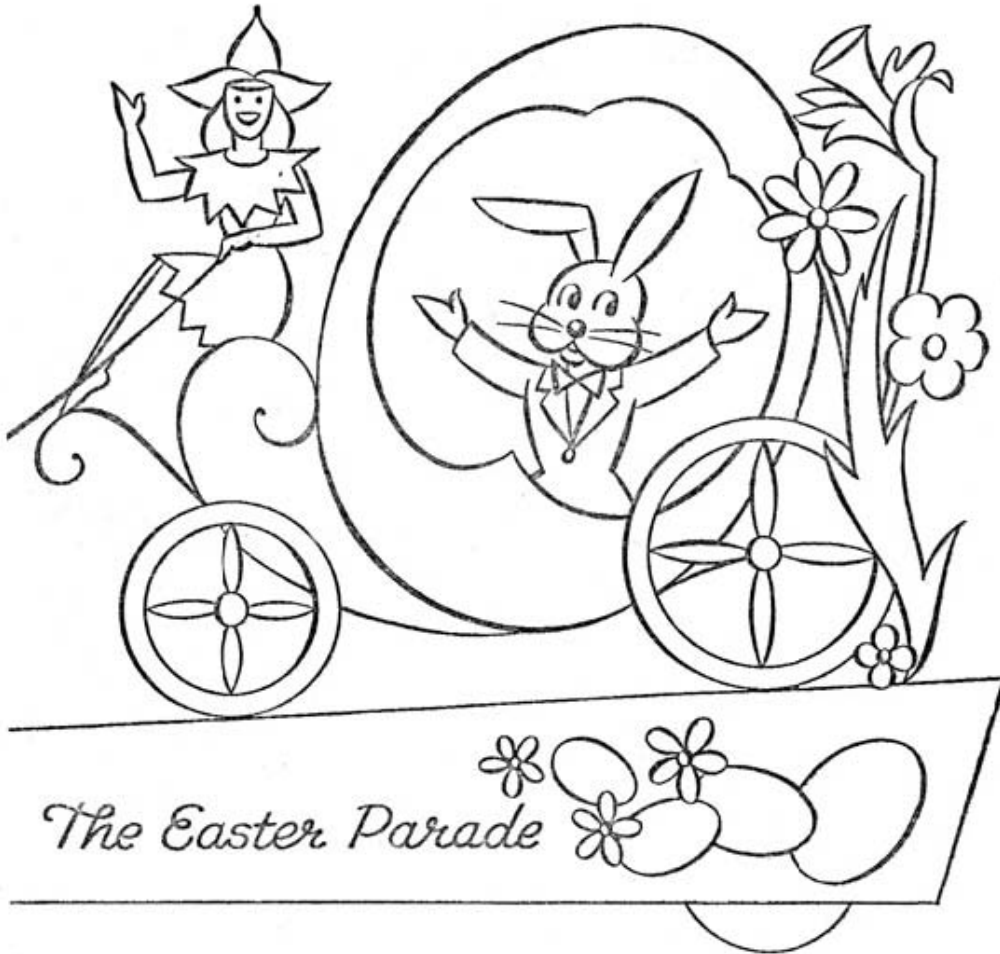

April's here! Happy April! With bouncy bunnies and chirpy chicks and chocolate eggs! And the gay Easter Parade in the golden sunlight!



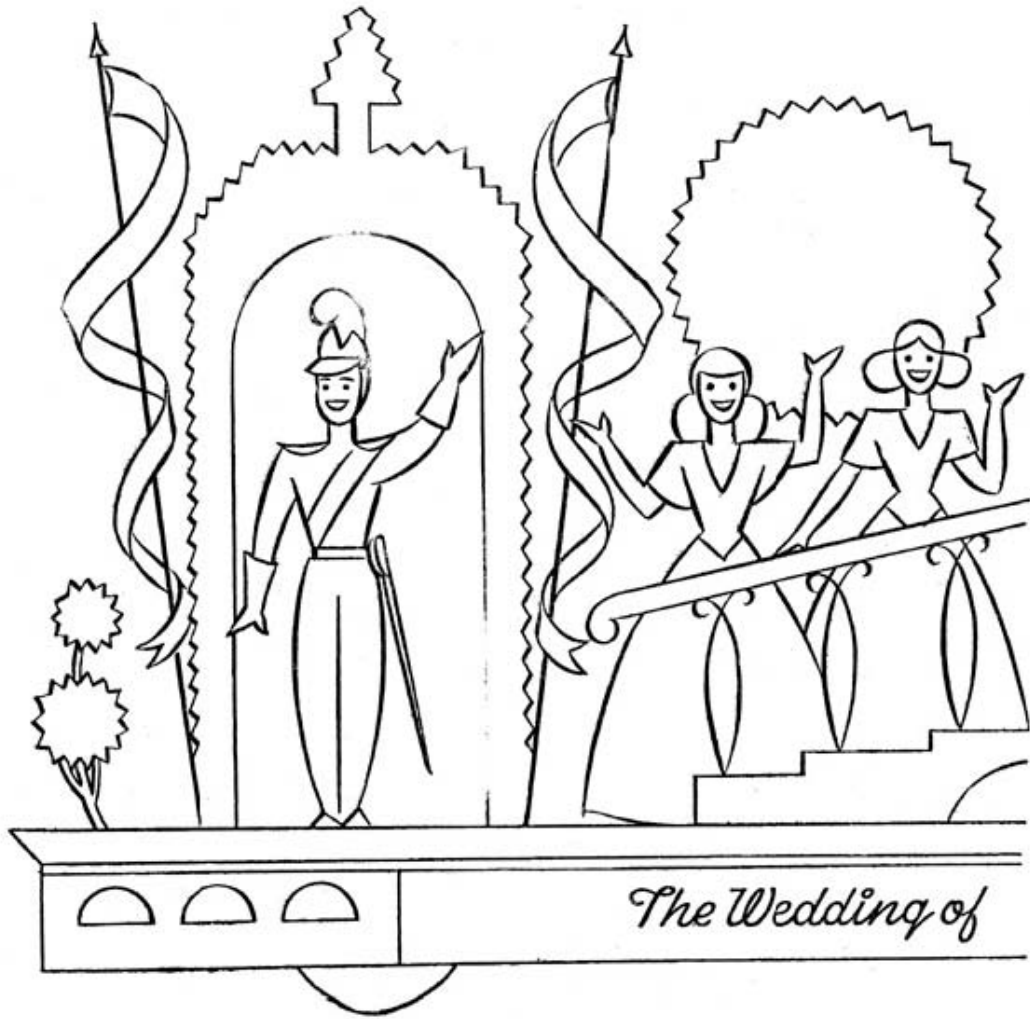

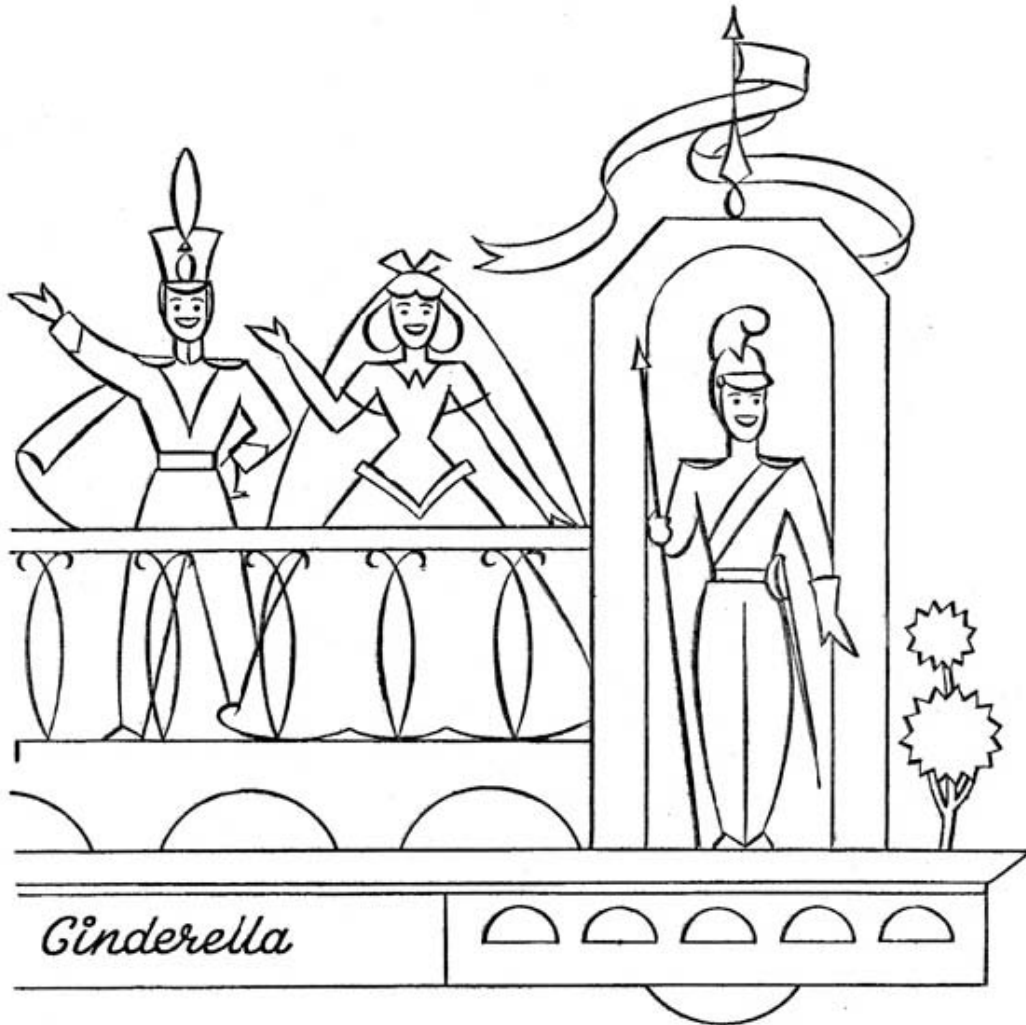

JUNE



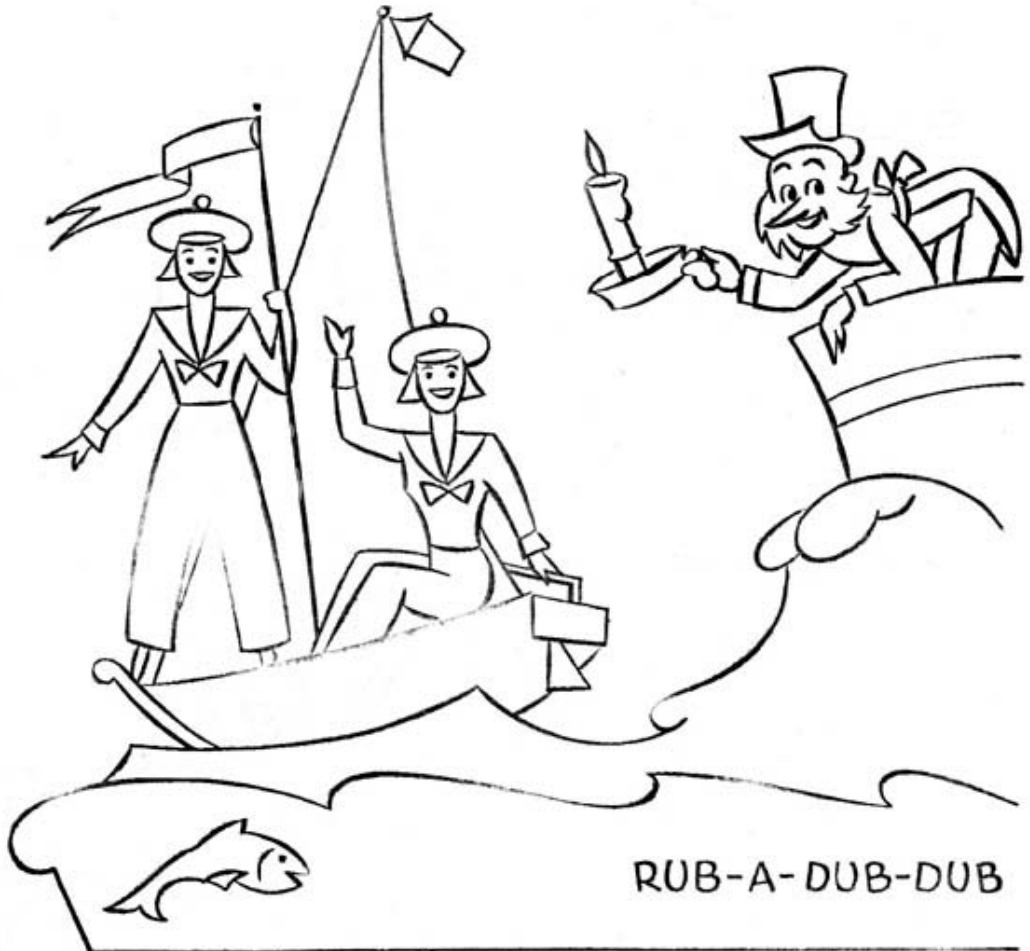
June is the month of marriages! In our land and in Storyland! Today we are guests at a most important wedding! Between Cinderella and her Prince!



What's a parade without clowns! Well, there are lots of clowns in the Parade of Happy Months! Look at these four funny fellows!

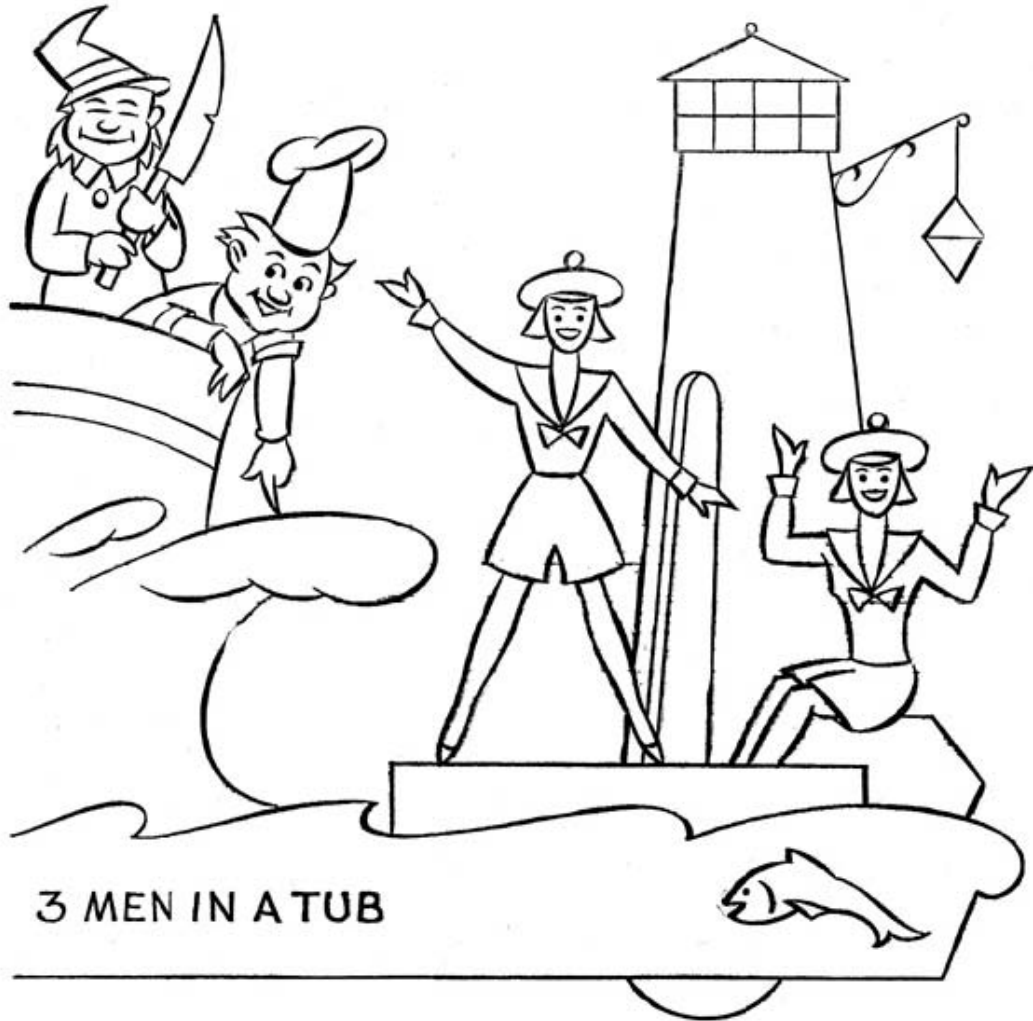


There's a clown for each of the four seasons . . . Spring,

time of their lives!



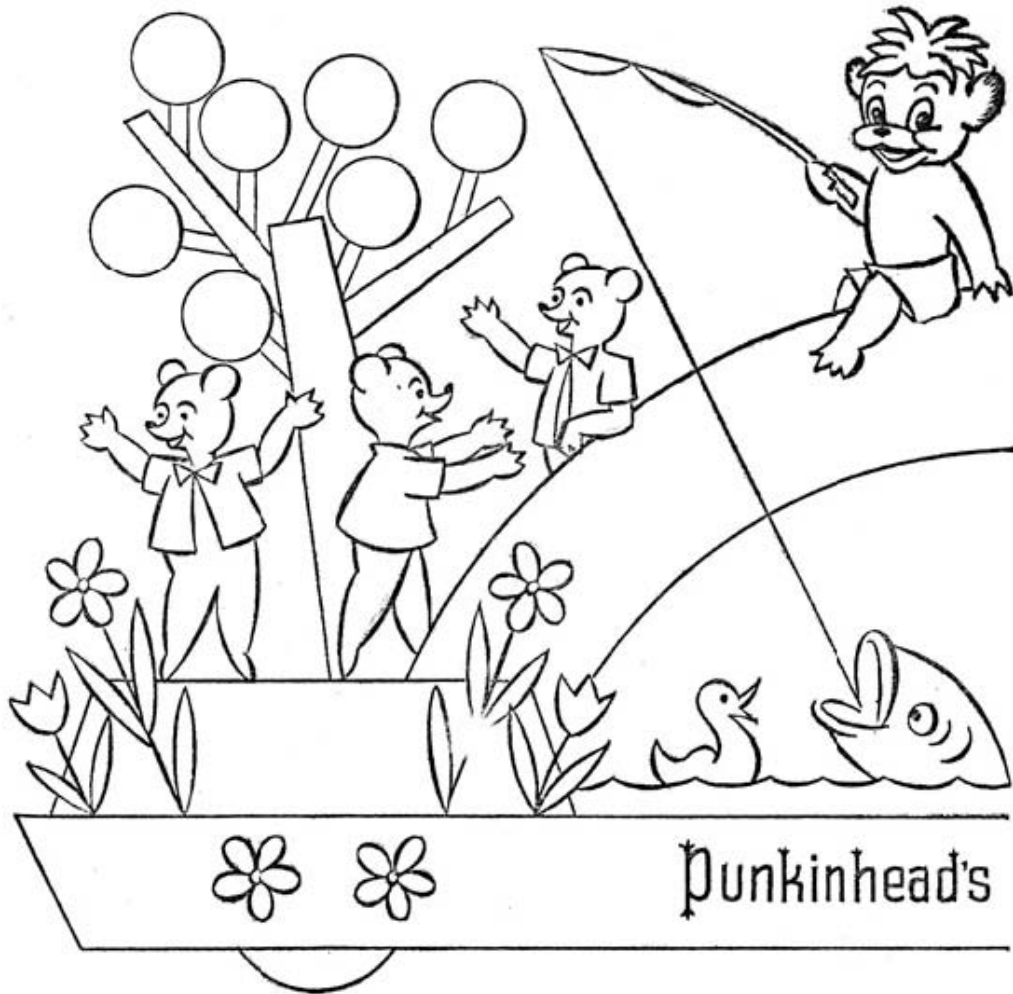

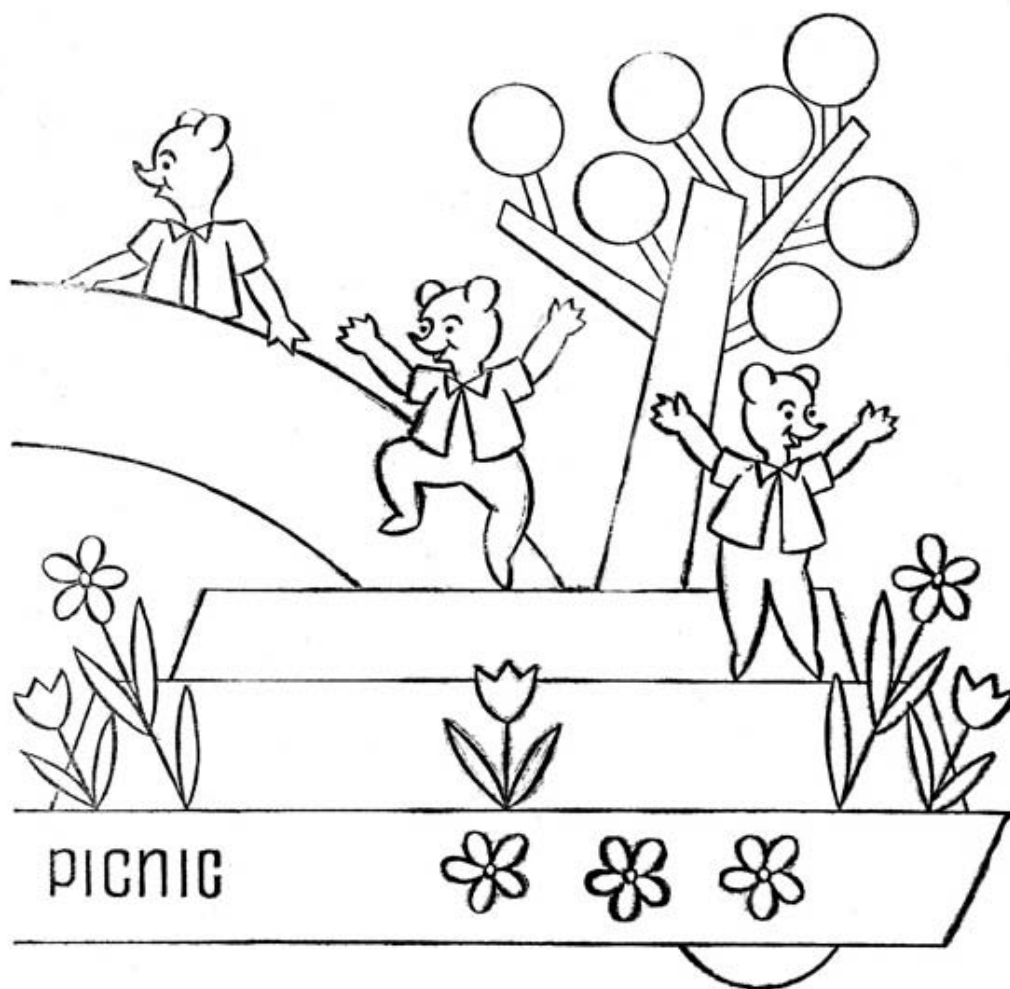


3 MEN IN A TUB

SEPTEMBER



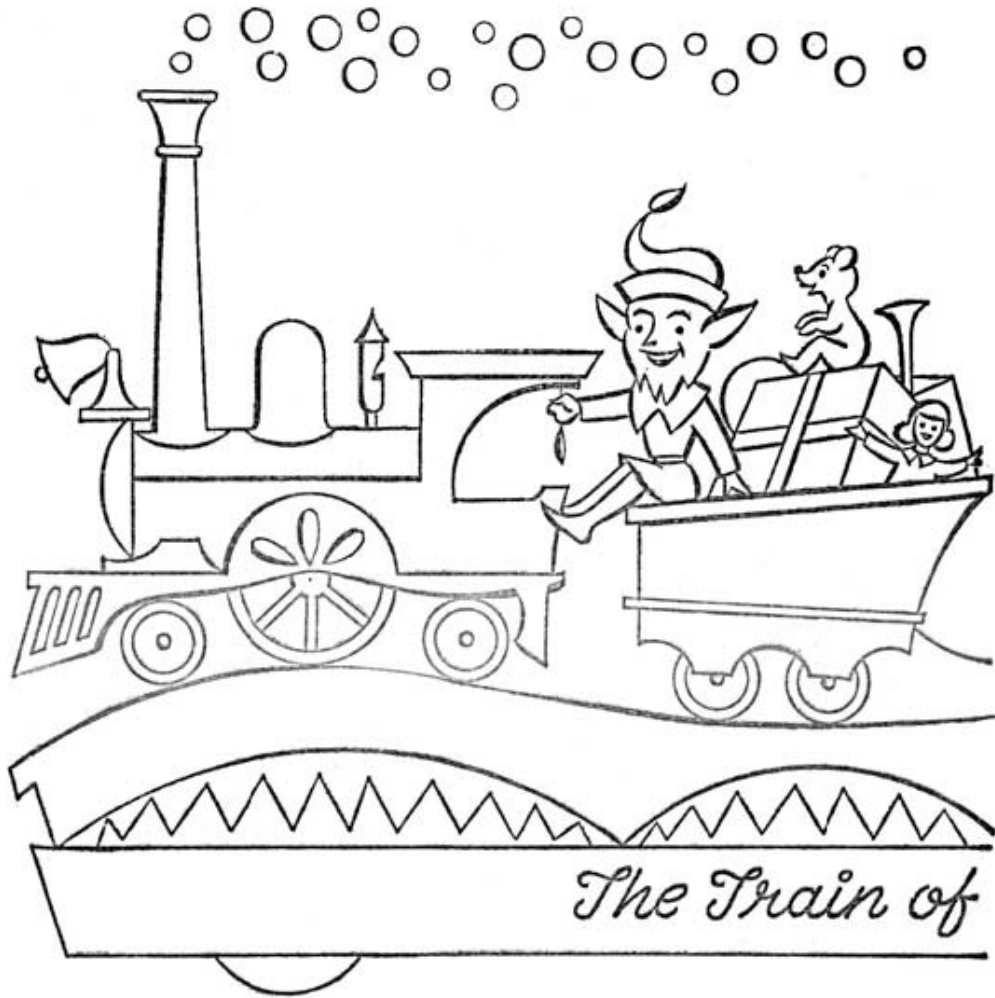
Ding dong! Ding dong! Yes, it is September! And the children of Nursery Land are coming back to Mother Hubbard's School! Hurry! Hurry!



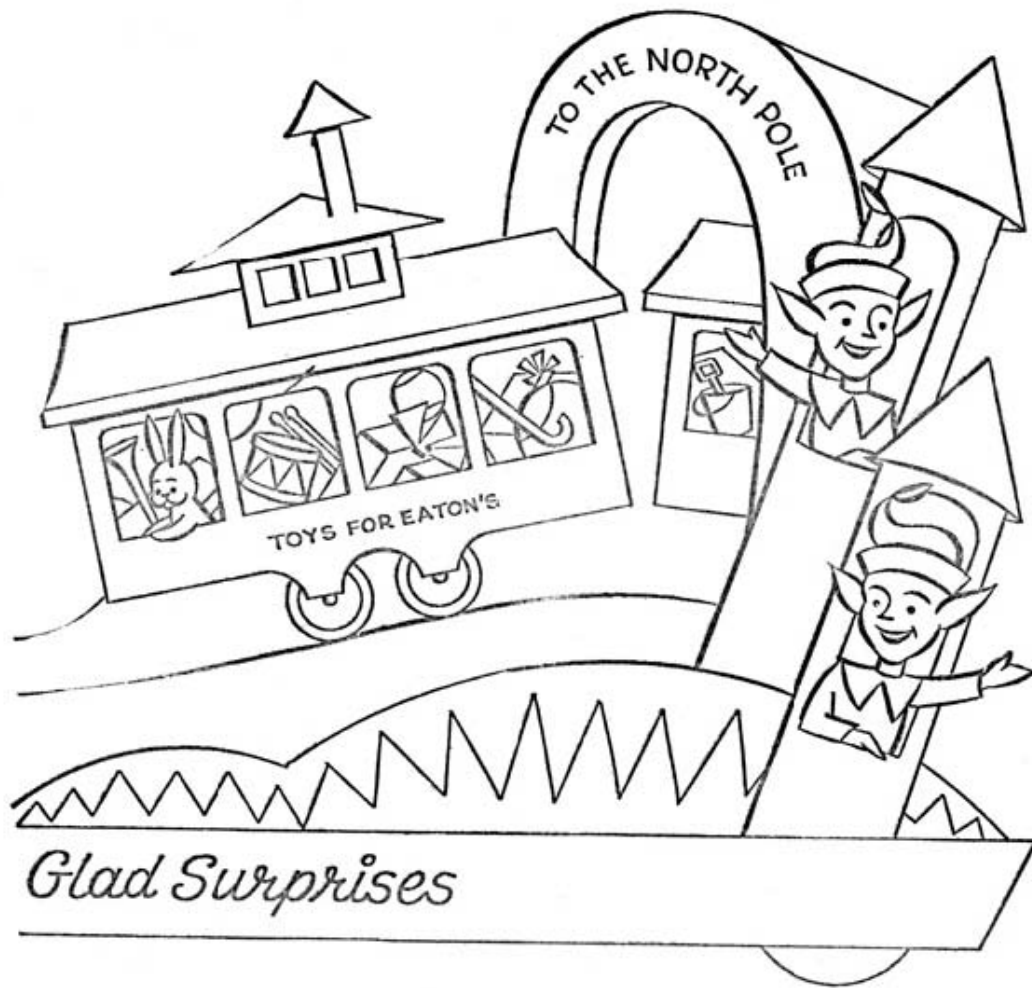

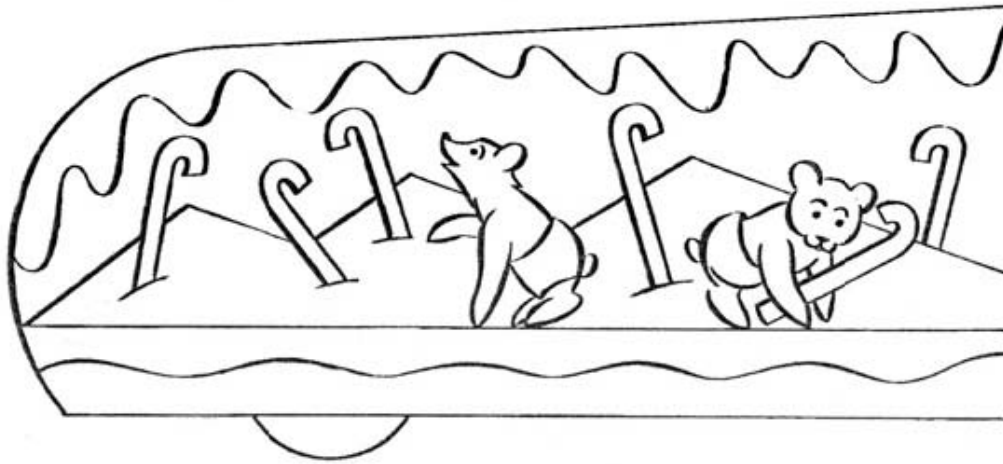
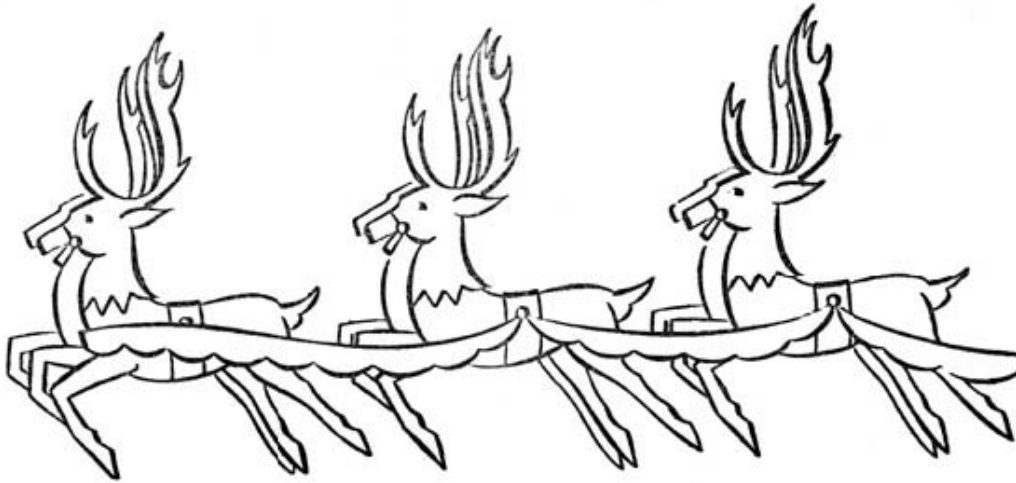
Way up at the North Pole, Santa's elves have been busy for months! Now, in November, they begin shipping their toys townward by express!
