countries in the world!




It's for boys and girls who have come to see Santa Claus!

watch the Happy Months roll by!




JANUARY

We say, "Perhaps this is the happiest month!"




MARCI



Sometimes it seems that every month is the happiest month! How we love March! When the winter wind turns playful and joins in jolly games!




APAIL

June is the month of marriages! In our land and in Storyland! Today we are guests at a most important wedding! Between Cinderella and her Prince!




What's a parade without clowns! Well, there are lots of clowns in the Parade of Happy Months! Look at these four funny fellows!



There's a clown for each of the four seasons... Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter! All of them are having the time of their lives!






Sailing over the bounding sea on a holiday in July!

Here comes the Butcher, the Baker and the Candlestick


Maker! What a merry crew!

# OGOBER




With October comes Hallowe'en! A night of thrills and chills! A world of lighted pumpkins and black cats and witches riding broomsticks!



# NOVEMBER




Way up at the North Pole, Santa's elves have been busy for months! Now, in November, they begin shipping their toys townward by express!




DECEMBER
