#### NEW COURT OF APPEAL ACT

The Court of Appeal Act, 2000 will come into force on November 1, 2000

- 1. Subsection 21(3) of the *The Court of Appeal Act, 2000* provides that:
  - 21(3) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations prescribing the fees and charges payable to the registrar.
- 2. Pursuant to *The Court of Appeal Act*, 2000, Your Honour made the *The Court of Appeal Regulations*, being chapter C-42 Reg 1 of the *Revised Regulations of Saskatchewan*.
- 3. It is considered expedient and in the public interest to repeal those regulations and enact new regulations.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### Title

1 These regulations may be cited in the The Court of Appeal Fees Regulations, 2000.

### **Registrar Fees**

- **2**(1) The fee payable to the registrar for a service set out in Column 1 of Table 1 of the Appendix is the fee set out opposite the service in Column 2.
  - (2) The fee payable to the registrar for a service not set out in Table 1 of the Appendix is the fee payable to the registrar for the same service pursuant to section 9 of *The Queen's Bench Regulations*.

## Fees payable in advance

All fees payable to the registrar are payable in advance unless other arrangements are made with the registrar.

# **Coming into force**

- **5**(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on the day on which section 21 of The *Court of Appeal Act*, *2000* comes into force.
  - (2) If these regulations are files with the Registrar of Regulations after the day on which section 21 of *The Court of Appeal Act, 2000* comes into force, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are files with the Registrar of Regulations.
