Dear stakeholders:

The Canadian Council of Insurance Regulators (CCIR) and the Canadian Insurance Services Regulatory Organizations (CISRO) are pleased to release *Managing Conflicts of Interest: A Consultation Paper on Enhancing and Harmonizing Best Practices*. The consultation paper seeks comments on recommendations designed to promote consumer confidence in the insurance industry.

This consultation paper is the third paper released by the Industry Practices Review Committee (IPRC) on managing actual or potential conflicts of interest in the insurance industry. In June 2005, the IPRC released the first consultation paper entitled *Relationships between Insurers and Sales Intermediaries*. In November 2005, the IPRC released the second paper entitled *Summary of Responses: Achieving Best Practices*. The recommendations described in the current paper have been developed based on these earlier papers and should be read in conjunction with them.

Following the review of comments provided by stakeholders, the IPRC will finalize its recommendations and report to the CCIR and CISRO in the Spring of 2006.

The IPRC looks forward to receiving submissions by March 24, 2006. Electronic submissions are preferred. Please note that the CCIR and CISRO intend to publicly release all submissions received as part of this consultation process by posting them on the CCIR website.
